AN ACT to open a Road over certain Lands in the Parish of Wangarie, in the County of Marsden, in the Province of Auckland.

WHEREAS it is desirable to open a line of Road over certain Lands in the Parish of Wangarie in the country of Marsden, the Property of Willoughby Brassey, described in the Schedule to this Act annexed,

Be it therefore enacted by the Superintendent of the Province of Auckland, with the advice and consent of the Provincial Council thereof, as follows:

1. From and after the passing of this Act the land mentioned and described in the Schedule to this Act shall be opened as a new line of Road, and the same shall for ever thereafter be used as, and be, a public Highway.

2. It shall be lawful for the said Superintendent from and out of the Public Revenue of the Province of Auckland to pay to the

said Willoughby Brassey, his heirs or assigns, such compensation as may be awarded under the provisions of the "Diversion of Roads Act, 1858."

3. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Road Act, No. , 1860."

SCHEDULE.

A Road commencing on the North Western boundary of a sub-division of Allotment 2 of the Parish of Wangarie, County of Marsden, known as Captain Brassey's lot, at a point 1890 links, South West from its northernmost angle, proceeding in a North Easterly direction through the said Willoughby Brassey's lot till it meets and terminates at a stream bounding the said lot on the North, where it joins the Paranui Road as the same is marked on a Plan numbered 1000, now lying in the Waste Land Office, which Road 100 links in width will be bounded on the North West by the said Captain Brassey's lot 400, 143, 276, 736, 294, and 489 links, and on the South East by the said Willoughby Brassey's lot 431, 280, 800, 360, 165 and 440 links, or thereabouts.

Be it therefore enacted by the Superintendent of the Province of Auckland, with the advice and consent of the Provincial Council thereof, as follows:

1. From and after the passing of this Act the land mentioned and described in the schedule to this Act shall be opened as a new line of Road, and the same shall from ever thereafter be used as and be a public Highway.

2. It shall be lawful for the said Superintendent from and out of the public Revenue of the Province of Auckland to pay to the said Robert Mair, his heirs or assigns, such compensation as may be awarded under the provisions of the "Diversion of Roads Act, 1858."

3. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Road Act, No. , 1860."

SCHEDULE.

A Road between the Bay of Islands and Ngunguru Roads, and commencing at a point 835 links from the junction of the two Roads

aforsaid, and running in an Easterly direction through Robert Mair's land, being a portion of lot 2 of the Parish of Wangarie, County of Marsden, until it joins the Ngunguru Road aforsaid, where it terminates as thatsame is marked upon a plan numbered 1000, now lying in the Waste Land's Office, which Road, 100 links in width, will be bounded on the North by a portion of lot 2 aforsaid 375 links, and on the South by other portions of lot 2 aforsaid 350 links or thereabouts.

1. From and after the passing of this Act the land mentioned and described in the Schedule to this Act shall be opened as a new line of Road, and the same shall from ever thereafter be used as, and be, a public Highway.

2. It shall be lawful for the said Superintendent from and out of the Public Revenue of the Province of Auckland to pay to the said William Bedlington, George Burnett, and William Mair, their heirs or assigns, such compensation as may be awarded under the provisions of the "Diversion of Roads Act, 1858."

3. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Road Act, No. 1860."

SCHEDULE.

A Road commencing on the Road from Wangarie to the Bay of Islands at a point within the boundary of a parcel of land, being a subdivision of lot 2 of the Parish of Wangarie, County of Marsden, known as William Bedlington's property, 400 links or thereabouts from its Northern boundary, and proceeding thence in a Westerly direction through the several parcels of land situated in the said lot 2 of the Parish of Wangarie, known as George Burnett's and William Mair's properties, to the Whau Whau block, terminating on a Road through the said block, as the same is marked upon a plan numbered 1000 now lying in the Waste Land Office, which

Road, being 100 links in width, will be bounded on the North by the said William Bedlington's property 280 links, by the said George Burnett's property 140 and 530 links, and by the said William Mair's property 440, 1145, 910, 360, 360, 830, 480, and 580 links, and on the South by the said William Mair's property 600, 522, 839, 321, 364, 880, 1,150, 398, and 260 links, by the said George Burnett's property 338 links, and by the said William Bedlington's property 560 links or thereabouts.

AN ACT to close up a certain Road in the Parish of Wangarie, in the County of Marsden, in the Province of Auckland, and to authorize the Governor to grant the Land occupied by the said Road to James Wooley and to open a new line of Road over certain other Lands in the said Parish, the property of the said James Wooley.

WHEREAS it is expedient to close up the Road mentioned and described in the Schedule A to this Act annexed, and to open a new Road in lieu thereof, over the Land described in Schedule B to this Act annexed: And whereas the said Road so to be closed up as aforesaid passes through certain Lands the property of James Wooley: And whereas the Land mentioned and described in the said Schedule B is the property of the said James Wooley,

Be it therefore enacted by the Superintendent of the Province of Auckland, by and with the advice and consent of the Provincial Council thereof, as follows:

1. From and after the passing of this Act the said Road mentioned and described in the Schedule A to this Act annexed, shall be closed.

2. It shall be lawful for His Excellency the Governor of New Zealand to grant the land occupied by the said Road to the said James Wooley, his heirs and assigns, in fee simple.

3. From and after the passing of this Act, the land mentioned and described in Schedule B to this Act, shall be opened as a new line of Road, and the same shall for ever thereafter be used as, and be, a public Highway.

4. It shall be lawful for the said Superintendent from and out of the Public Revenue of the Province of Auckland, to pay to the said James Wooley, his heirs, or assigns, such compensation as may be awarded under the provisions of the "Diversion of Roads Act, 1858."

5. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Road Act, No. , 1860."

SCHEDULE A.

That portion of the Road from Wangarie to Ngunguru commencing at a point within the boundary of a parcel of land being a subdivision of lot 2 of the Parish of Wangarie, County of Marsden, and known as James Wooley's property, 700 links or thereabouts from a stream forming the southern boundary of the said James Wooley's property, and proceeding thence in a northerly direction through the property of the said James Wooley and terminating on the Ngunguru Road aforesaid, where it crosses the division boundary of the said James Wooley and John Foster, as the same is marked upon a plan numbered 1000, now lying in the Waste Land's Office, which road, 100 links in width, is bounded on the West by the said James Wooley's property, 2200 links, and on the East by the said James Wooley's property 2100 links or thereabouts.

SCHEDULE B.

A Road commencing on the Road from Wangarie to Ngunguru at a point within the boundary of a parcel of land being a subdivision of lot 2 of the Parish Wangarie, County of Marsden, and known as James Wooley's property 700 links or thereabouts from a stream forming the southern boundary of the said James Wooley's property, and proceeding thence in a northerly direction through the said James Wooley's property and terminating on the Ngunguru Road aforesaid, where it crosses the division boundary between the said James Wooley and John Foster, as the same is marked upon a plan numbered 1000, now lying in the Waste Land's Office, which road, 100 links in width, will be bounded on the West by James Wooley's property 40, 110, 344, 272, 242, 230, 160, 170, 284, 416, 270, 360 and 320 links, and on the East by the said James Wooley's property, 60, 165, 375, 255, 195, 115, 90, 143, 301, 416, 291, 384, and 353 links or thereabouts.
