SIR,—I have the honour to report for your information that I find it to be impossible without the co-operation of the settlers to carry out the provisions of the Thistle Act so thoroughly as is desirable.

I would refer more particularly to the different contracts which have been taken to eradicate them in the sub-districts.

I would therefore take the liberty to suggest that your Honour would give some notice that it would be necessary for the efficient working of the contracts that settlers should forward information to the Inspector relative to the existence of Thistles.
