chase Department, to the Chief Commissioner,
reporting the discovery of a Quartz Reef at
Coromandel.

Auckland, August 13th, 1862.

SIR,—I have the honor to inform you that,
during the perambulation of the external
boundaries of Paul's land, Coromandel, on the
9th of July, I discovered a quartz reef of con-
siderable extent situated about half-a-mile up
the Hakaroa Stream, a branch of the Whanga-
rahi, on Ring's Creek, and distant from Ring's
mill about two miles.

I estimate the reef to be about 220 yards
wide and 200 feet thick. These dimensions I
was enabled to arrive at by the fact of the
stream running diagonally through the reef
and exposing to view the solid quartz rock.
A small speck of gold was picked up by one
of my men just below the reef, in the bed of
the stream; but I was unable to make a more
thorough examination from the nature of the
work upon which I was engaged, and also
from the want of the necessary implements.

PUBLIC NOTIFICATION.

of the Superintendent of the
Province of Auckland.

WHEREAS a majority of the persons
occupying property liable to be rated
under the provisions of the "Local Improve-
ment Act, 1858," having a frontage to the
road leading from the Cathedral Library to
Hay's Creek, Oraki Bay, and passing between
lots 4 and 8, 5 and 9, 6 and 11, 7 and 12 of
section No. 4, and between lots 1 & 3 of sec-
tion No. 14, in the suburbs of Auckland, and
occupying at least one-half of the frontage to
the said road, have represented to me that they

are willing to be specially rated for the purpose
of improving the said road.

Now therefore, I, the said Deputy of the
Superintendent, for the purpose of raising one
moiety of the estimated cost of the said im-
provements, do hereby, by virtue of the power
and authority by the said Act given, order and
direct that an equitable rate, at the rate of five
shillings for every chain of frontage to the said
road, be levied upon all real property having a
frontage to the said road, except upon such
land as is by the said Act excepted. And I
do hereby appoint that the said rate shall be
paid and payable to ROBERT BAILIE LUSK,
at the Provincial Treasury, on Wednesday the
22nd day of October next; and I do hereby
further give notice that in the schedule here-
under written, is set forth a list of the names
of the persons liable for the payment of such
rate, and the amount payable by each such
person.
