## PROCLAMATION.

By JOHN WILLIAMSON, Esq., Superintendent of the Province of Auckland, in the Colony of New Zealand.

**W**HEREAS by an Act made and passed in the Parliament holden in the fifteenth and sixteenth years of the reign of Her present Majesty, intituled "An Act to grant a Representative Constitution to the Colony of New Zealand," it is amongst other things enacted that it shall be lawful for the Superintendent, by proclamation in the *Government Gazette*, to fix such place or places within the limits of the Province, and such times for holding the first and every other session of the Provincial Council as he may think fit.

Now, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority in me vested in that behalf, I, the Superintendent of the Province of Auckland, do hereby proclaim and declare, that the twenty-first session of the Provincial Council shall be holden at Auckland, and shall commence on Monday, the seventeenth day of June, 1867, and the Members of the said Council are hereby warned to give their attendance at the said time and place accordingly.

Extract from a Lecture delivered ON THE

PRODUCTION OF THE FLAX PLANT, &c., by  
MR. JAMES MACADAM, Junr.

"In New Zealand, the *Phormium tenax* has so much occupied attention, that few trials have yet been made of the *Linum usitatissimum*, with which it is often confounded, from the term *flax* being indiscriminately applied to both plants. I have no hesitation in saying, that from their humid climate and maritime position those islands should be peculiarly suited to its growth; and it is not at all unlikely, that, as population increases, New Zealand may be a large exporter of flax fibre."
