##### 1.—EAST TAMAKI DISTRICT.

Former boundaries detailed in Gazette No. 10, vol. X., folios 63 and 64, 1862.

##### *Amended Boundaries.*

Bounded on the north by the northern boundaries of lots 26, 27, 85, 97, and 80, of the parish of Pakuranga, from a branch of the Tamaki river, to the road which forms the eastern boundaries of lot 80 aforesaid; on the east by the before mentioned road, which also forms the eastern boundaries of lots 116, 90, 18, and 104, to the north-western angle of lot 217, thence by the road which forms the northern boundaries of lots 217 aforesaid, 270, 271, 273, and 275, to the western angle of lot 118, thence by the north and part of the eastern boundaries of lot 118 aforesaid, part of the south-western boundary of lot 131, part of the south-eastern boundary of lot 139, the eastern boundary of lot 176, the eastern boundary of lot 175, and the eastern boundary of lot 137, all of the parish of Pakuranga, the north and east and part of the southern boundary of lot 91 of the parish of Manurewa, and the eastern boundary of lot 94 to Clendon's grant; on the south by the northern and part of the north-western boundaries of Clendon's grant aforesaid, from the south-eastern angle of lot 94 aforesaid to the southern angle of lot 40 of the parish of Manurewa aforesaid, thence by the road which forms the south-western boundaries of lot 40 aforesaid, 39, 36, 12, and 11 to the southern boundary of lot 10

and by the same road continued through lots 10 and 9 to the Tamaki river; and on the west by the Tamaki river aforesaid to the point of commencement.

Bounded on the north by the southern boundary of the Kaurihohore Highways District; on the east by the Waitaua river, the Whangarei river, and the Kote hahacreek, until it intersects a line coming in a south-easterly direction from the south-east angle of the Pukenui block; thence on the south by the aforesaid line to the aforesaid angle; and on the west by the eastern boundaries of the Pukenui block aforesaid and the Whau-Whau block and the western boundaries of Mair's grant and the Kamo block, and a road running through the Te Pua block to the Waitaua river.

##### 3.—WAIROA DISTRICT.

##### *Amended Boundaries.*

takerei block, and the north-western boundaries of Dilworth's claim to Raupo Tamaki, and by the southern boundary of the Taupaki block to Russell's claim; on the east by Russell's claim aforesaid, the western boundary of the Kumeu block, and part of the north-western boundary of Brigham's claim, to the Great North Road, and by the Great North Road to the northern boundary of Henderson and Macfarlane's claim; on the south by part of the northern boundaries of Henderson and Macfarlane's claim to the Waitakerei Range Road, thence by the aforesaid road to the north-eastern angle of Lot 9 of the parish of Waitakerei, and by the south-eastern boundaries of that lot and lot 8 of same parish and the Waitakerei native reserve to the sea; and on the west by the sea to the Wairere stream aforesaid.

#### 6.—PUKEKOHE DISTRICT.

Former boundaries detailed in Gazette No. 10, vol. X., folio 64, 1862.

##### *Amended Boundaries.*

Bounded on the north by the southern boundaries of allotments Nos. 60 and 79, the southern and eastern boundaries of lot 82, part of the eastern boundary of lot 74 and the southern boundary of lot No. 81, all of the parish of Karaka, part of the western boundary of lot 56, the western and southern boundaries of lot 55, the southern and part of the eastern boundary of lot 54, and the southern boundary of lot 51, all of the parish of Opaheke, to the Great South Road; on the east by the Great South Road aforesaid to the Waikato river; on the south by the Waikato river aforesaid to the eastern boundary of Camerontown; and on the west by the eastern boundary of Camerontown aforesaid, and part of the eastern boundary of a grant to John Williamson, Esq., and the north-western boundary of lot No. 44, to lot No. 74, being a native reserve, thence by the western boundary of the aforesaid native reserve to the point of commencement.

#### 7.—WAIPU DISTRICT.

Former boundaries detailed in Gazette No. 18, vol. X., folio 111, 1862.

##### *Amended Boundaries.*

Bounded on the north by the southern boundaries of the Mangapai and Ruakaka blocks; on the north-east by the east coast from Uretiti to the north-western boundary of the village of Molesworth; on the south-east by the north-western boundary of Molesworth aforesaid, the road from Mangawai to Waipu the north-western boundary of Mr. Henry's selection and a native reserve; and on the south-west by the north-eastern boundaries of the parishes of Kaiwaka and Wairau and by the Great North Road.

#### 8.—WHAREORA DISTRICT.

Former boundaries detailed in Gazette No. 8, vol. XI., folio 62, 1863.

##### *Amended Boundaries.*

Bounded on the north by the northern boundary of Sir Robert Douglass's land claim; and the northern boundary of the Whareora block from the Waitaua river to the north-eastern angle of lot 59 of the parish of Parahaki; thence on the north-east by the north-eastern boundary of the Whareora block aforesaid, to the top of the Whanui mountain; on the south by the southern boundary of the Whareora block aforesaid, to the northern angle of lot 203 of the parish of Owhiwa; thence from that angle and by the north-western boundary of lot 208 aforesaid, and the south-western boundary of lot 209, to the eastern angle of lot 7, of the parish of Wariara; thence by the south-eastern boundary of lot 7 aforesaid and the south-eastern boundaries of lots 6, 5, 4, and 3, of the parish of Wariara aforesaid, and the western and southern boundaries of Dent's grant to the Whangarei river; on the south-west by the Whangarei river aforesaid; and on the north-west by the Waitaua river.

#### 9.—WAITAKEREI SOUTH DISTRICT.

Former boundaries detailed in Gazette No. 34, vol. XI., folio 193, 1863.

##### *Amended Boundaries.*

Bounded on the north by the northern boundaries of the parish of Karangahape, and part of the southern boundaries of Henderson and Macfarlanes' claim to the north-eastern angle of Lot 6 of the parish of Waikomiti; on the east by Lot 6 aforesaid to Parr's creek; on the south-east by Parr's creek aforesaid to Lot 68 of the parish of Waikomiti aforesaid, thence by the northern boundaries of Lot 68 aforesaid, the eastern, northern, and western boundaries of Lot 76, the western boundaries of Lots 70 and 38, the northern and western boundaries of Lot 82, the northern boundary of Lot 73, and the northern and western

boundaries of Lot 74, to Big Muddy Creek, thence by that creek to a line, being a production of the south-eastern boundaries of Lots 79 and 78, thence by the aforesaid line and the south and south-eastern boundaries of the surveyed portion of the Waitakerei block to the sea; and on the west by the sea.

#### 10.—TURANGA DISTRICT.

Former boundaries detailed in Gazette No. 25, vol. XIV., folio 227, 1865.

##### *Amended Boundaries.*

Bounded on the north by the Maungamaungaroa and its tributaries, to the south-western angle of lot 34 of the parish of Maraetai on the Waikopu creek, thence by the southern boundary of lot 34 aforesaid, and the southern boundaries of 46, to the north-western boundary of the parish of Wairoa; on the east by the north-western boundary of the Wairoa Highways District, which also forms the north-western boundary of the parish of Wairoa, to the west angle of lot 27 of said parish; on the south by part of the south-eastern boundaries of lot 190 of the parish of Pakuranga, the south-eastern and south-western boundaries of lot 65, the south-western boundaries of 63, and part of the south eastern boundary of lot 64, all of said parish, to the north-eastern boundary of lot 96 of the parish of Manurewa, thence by the said boundary, and south-eastern and southern boundaries of said lot, and southern boundary of lot 95, to the eastern boundary of the Tamaki East Highways District; and on the west by the eastern boundary of the Tamaki East Highways District aforesaid, to the north-western angle of lot 235 of the Parish of Pakuranga, and thence by the north-western boundary of 235 aforesaid, to the Maungamaungaroa.

Bounded on the north-east by the Waipu Highways District, from the south-western boundary of the Mareretu block to the north-east angle of the Wairau block; on the east by the eastern boundaries of Wright and Grahames' claims; on the south by the southern boundary of Grahame's claim aforesaid and the Otamatea river, to the southern boundary of the Maungaturoto block, thence by the aforesaid boundary to the eastern boundary of the Paparoa Highways District; and on the north-west by the Paparoa Highways District aforesaid, and the south-eastern boundary of the Mareretu block aforesaid, to the point of commencement.

#### 12.—PAPAKURA DISTRICT.

Former boundaries detailed in Gazette No. 10, vol. X., folio 64, 1862.

Bounded on the north-east by the line which
