PUBLIC NOTIFICATION.

WHEREAS by an Act made and passed by the Superintendent of the Province of Auckland, with the advice and consent of the Provincial Council thereof, intitled the "Auckland Municipal Police Act, 1866," it is amongst other things enacted that the Superintendent may from time to time, by public notification in the Provincial Government Gazette, appoint and define the limits of cities, towns, and other places within the Province of Auckland, for the purposes of this Act,

Now therefore I, the Superintendent of the Province of Auckland, pursuant to the authority vested in me in that behalf, do hereby proclaim and declare that for the purposes of the said "Auckland Municipal Police Act, 1866," the limits of the TOWN OF SHORTLAND, within which the said Act shall from the date hereof come into force, shall comprise all those lands, bounded on the west by the sea, on the south-west and south by the Wai Whuka Urunga Creek to the Church Mission Station on the east by a line on a bearing of north 37° west from the Church

Mission Station, to the Karaka Stream, and on the north by the Karaka Stream to the sea.
