ADDITIONAL REGULATION.

Superintendent's Office,
Auckland, 27th January, 1868.

IN pursuance of the authority vested in me by "The Wharf Regulation Act, 1858," I have, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, made the following additional Regulation; and I hereby give notice that the same will come into operation at the expiration of one month after a copy thereof shall have been published in the *Provincial Government Gazette*.

The master or person in charge of any vessel, previous to hauling alongside the Queen-street Wharf, shall provide a substantial and suitable gangway for the safe landing of passengers or other persons, of not less than thirty (30) inches in width; and the master or person in charge shall, between the hours of sunset and sunrise, burn a clear light to indicate the position of the gangway, subject to the approval of the Portmaster or Harbour-master, or persons deputed by them.

Any person guilty of a breach or non-performance of this Regulation, shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding £20, nor less than £5.

1. WHAKAPAKU DISTRICT.

(Former boundaries detailed in Gazette No. 58, vol. xvi., fol. 543.)

Amended Boundaries.

Bounded on the north by the sea from Flat Head to Wangaroa Harbour; on the east by Wangaroa harbour to the Pupuke river on the south-east by the Pupuke river and the north-western boundary of the Pupuke block and the south-eastern boundary of the Kohumaru block, on the south-west by the south-western boundary of the Kohumaru block; on the west by the western boundary of the Kohumaru block, on the north-west by the north-western boundary of the Kohumaru block to the Mongonui river; again on the south-west by the Mongonui river; and on the west by the Mongonui harbour and Doubtless Bay to the point of commencement.

2. MONGONUI DISTRICT.

(Former boundaries detailed in Gazette No. 58, vol xvi. fol. 543).

Amended Boundaries.

Bounded on the north by Doubtless Bay from the Ahurere river to Mongonui harbour on the east by Mongonui harbour and Mongonui river; on the south-east by the north-western boundary of the Kohumaru block; again on the east by the western boundary of the Kohumaru block; on the north-east by the south-western boundary of the Kohumaru, and the north-eastern boundary of Maungataniwha block No. 3 from the

Tauapuku river to the south-eastern angle of the Maungataniwha block No. 3; on the south-east and south by the south-eastern and southern boundaries of Maungataniwha blocks Nos. 1, 2, and 3; on the west by the western boundary of Maungataniwha block No. 1, and by a right line from the north-western angle of said block to the north-eastern angle of Maungatete block, thence by the northern boundary of Maungatete block aforesaid, and the eastern boundaries of the Waiake and Ahurere blocks to the place of commencement.
