PROCLAMATION.

By JOHN WILLIAMSON, Esquire,
Superintendent of the Province of Auckland.

WHEREAS, by an Act of the Local Legislature of the Province of Auckland, intituled "An Act to consolidate and amend the Laws relating to Slaughter-houses," (Session xix, No. 5,) it was amongst other things enacted that it should be lawful for the Superintendent of the said Province, by proclamation in the *Provincial Government Gazette*, from time to time, to constitute and define Slaughter-house Districts, and to appoint one or more Public Slaughter-houses for each of such Districts;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the power so vested in me in that behalf by the said Act, I, JOHN WILLIAMSON, the Superintendent of the said Province, do hereby proclaim that I do constitute and define the TOWN OF SHORTLAND to be a Slaughter-house District, within the meaning of the said Act, the limits of which shall comprise all those lands, bounded on the west by the sea, on the south-west and south by the Wai Whuka Urunga Creek to the Church Mission Station, on the east by a line on a bearing of North 37° West from the Church Mission Station, to the Karaka Stream, and on the north by the Karaka Stream to the sea.

AND I do further proclaim that I do appoint the premises situate at Karaka Creek, erected by Mr. William Walters, of Auck-

land, and likewise those premises situate at Waiwhakaurunga, erected by Messrs. George McLeod and Struan Robertson, to be respectively Public Slaughter-houses for the said District, within the meaning of the said Act.

A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS by an Act of the General Assembly of New Zealand, intituled “The Protection of Animals Act, 1867,” it is enacted that no native game shall be hunted, shot, taken or killed in any part of the Colony except during the months of April, May, June, and July in each year. And whereas by the said Act it is further enacted that it shall be lawful for the Governor, from time to time, by proclamation published in the *New Zealand Gazette*, to declare that all or any of the provisions of the said Act relating to native game shall not be in force in such parts of the Colony as he shall in and by such proclamation define:

Now therefore, I, Sir George Ferguson Bowen, the Governor of the Colony of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the power and authority in me vested in that behalf by the above-recited Act, do hereby proclaim and declare that the provisions of “The Protection of Animals Act, 1867,” relating to native game, shall not be in force within the Tauranga, Maketu, and Opotiki Districts, as the same districts are defined in a schedule to a proclamation bearing date the twenty-ninth of November, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-seven, constituting districts to be called Resident Magistrates' Districts.

Given under the hand of His Excellency Sir George Ferguson Bowen, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over Her Majesty's Co-

lony of New Zealand and its Dependencies, and Vice-Admiral of the same, at the Government House, at Wellington, and issued under the Public Seal of the Colony, this seventeenth day of February, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty-eight.
