IN compliance with a Requisition presented to me this day, a copy of which is published for general information, I hereby notify that the Offices of the Provincial Government will be closed at two o'clock in the afternoon of **TUESDAY** next, the 20th instant; and I invite the Merchants, Bankers, Tradespeople, and others of Auckland to close their places of business at the same hour on that day, in order to afford the Inhabitants an opportunity of bidding farewell to the Right Reverend George Augustus Selwyn, D.D., Bishop of New Zealand and Lichfield, upon His Lordship's departure from this Colony.
