As it is proposed that a General Illumination in the City of Auckland shall take place on the evening of the Queen's Birthday, and, with a view to prevent the occurrence of any accident upon that occasion through the discharge of Fireworks, the attention of the Public is directed to the twenty-sixth sub-section of section five of "The Auckland Municipal Police Act, 1866," whereby any person "discharging any fire-arms, or setting off any fireworks or explosive material on any street, highway, or public place, or so near thereto as to endanger or annoy the passers-by," shall be liable to a penalty as set forth in the said Act.
