dated 26th September, 1867, page 417.

AMENDED BOUNDARIES.

Bounded towards the North by the Waikato River; towards the South-east by the confiscation boundary line as far as the Eastern angle of the parish of Puniu; towards the South-west and South by the North-eastern and part of the Northern boundary of the parish of Puniu aforesaid to the South-eastern angle of allotment No. 181 of the parish of Nga Roto; towards the West by the Eastern boundary of the parish of Nga Roto aforesaid; again towards the
