PROCLAMATION.

By THOMAS BANNATYNE GILLIES,
Esquire, Superintendent of the
Province of Auckland.

IN exercise of the powers vested in me in that behalf by "The Slaughter-house Act, 1866," of the Superintendent and Provincial Council of the Province of Auckland, I, THOMAS BANNATYNE GILLIES, the said Superintendent, do hereby proclaim and declare that the provisions of Section 8, of "The Slaughter-house Act, 1866," aforesaid, are extended to the Town of GRAHAMSTOWN, the boundaries of which are as follows: Commencing at a point on the proper right bank of the Karaka Creek, near Vickery's Machine; thence Northerly by lines 2,600 links or thereabouts; thence Westerly by lines 780 links; thence Southerly by lines 822 links; thence in a Northerly direction along the foot of the range 4,310 links; thence to the sea beach Westerly 623 links; thence by the sea beach ordinary high water mark to the mouth of the Karaka Creek; thence up the right hand bank of the Karaka Creek to the commencing point, all distances being approximate.
