THE GRAFTON ROAD HIGHWAY DISTRICT.

Amended Boundaries.

Bounded towards the north by the southern boundary of section number 34 of the City of Auckland, from Symonds-street to the Grafton road, thence by the centre of Grafton road aforesaid, and by the centre of the road which forms the southern boundary of section number 10 of the City of Auckland aforesaid, to Stanley-street, thence by the centre of Stanley-street aforesaid, and by the centre of the road to the Government domain, and by the centre of said road produced to the western boundary of said Government domain; towards the east by the western boundaries of the Government domain and Hospital Reserve to the road (known as Park road) which forms the northern boundaries of allotments numbers 20, 21, and 22, of section number 3 of the suburbs of

THE NEWMARKET HIGHWAY DISTRICT.

Amended Boundaries.

and towards the west by the centre of the road which forms the western boundary of allotment number 29 aforesaid, and being known as the Mount Eden Stockade road to its junction with the Kyber Pass road, thence westerly by the centre of the Kyber Pass road aforesaid to a line, being the production of the western boundary of subdivisional lot number 13 of original allotment number 4 of section number 3 of the suburbs of Auckland aforesaid, thence by said right line and by the western boundary of subdivisional lot number 13 last-named, and by the western boundaries of subdivisional lots numbers 116, 115, 106, 105, 96, 95, 86, 85, 76, 75, 66, 65, 56, 55, and 37, all of original allotment number 4, of section number 6 of the suburbs aforesaid, and by the production in a northerly direction of the western boundary of subdivisional lot number 37 last-named to the centre of the road known as the Carleton Gore road thence easterly by the centre of Carleton Gore road aforesaid to a right line, being the production of the eastern boundary of allotment number 22 of section number 3 of the suburbs of Auckland aforesaid, thence by said line and by the eastern boundary of allotment number 22 of the section and suburbs last-named, and by said eastern boundary produced to the northern side of Park road aforesaid—the place of commencement.

THE REMUERA HIGHWAY DISTRICT.

Amended Boundaries.
