Bye-law adopted by the Auckland Harbour Board, at a Meeting held on Tuesday, the 25th day of February, 1873.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in the Auckland Harbour Board, the said Board do hereby make the following Regulations or Bye-laws, and do declare that the same shall come into operation and take effect on and after the first day of March, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-three.

1. Section 65 of the Harbour and Quarantine Regulations made by Order in Council at the Government House Wellington on the twenty-fifth day of June one thousand eight hundred and sixty-eight shall not apply to vehicles drawn by horses in double

harness on the Queen-street Wharf at the City of Auckland.

2. Any person in charge of a vehicle drawn by horses in double harness upon the said Wharf shall not leave the driver's seat during the time the vehicle is in motion and shall not drive at a faster pace than a walk and any person acting contrary to this regulation shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding ten pounds.
