LICENSES to Kill and Sell Game are now issuable at the Superintendent's Office, Auckland.

The Season for Killing Game extends over the months of May and June only.

Licenses to Sell Game are in force until the 7th of July only.

No Shilling Licenses are issued under the new Act; but any person in *bona fide* occupation of any land, not being Waste Lands of the Crown, (or some one person appointed by him) may kill Game on such land without a License.

Every person who shall sell, offer for sale, or expose for sale, and every holder of a License to sell Game, who shall have in his possession, or shall in any manner dispose of, any dead hen pheasant or any dead tui, shall, on conviction, forfeit and pay for every such act a sum not exceeding Twenty Pounds; and if such person hold a License to Kill or Sell Game, such License shall, on conviction, become *ipso facto* void.
