PROCLAMATION.

By JOSEPH MAY, Esquire, Deputy Superintendent of the Province of Auckland.

WHEREAS by "The Highway Boards Empowering Act, 1871," it is enacted that the Superintendent of any Province, upon recommendation of the Provincial Council, may from time to time, by Proclamation, declare that any or all of the parts of the said Act, numbered two, three, four, five, six, and seven, shall extend and apply to any Highway District constituted or to be constituted by or under any Provincial Act theretofore or thereafter to be passed, or to the inhabitants, ratepayers, or governing body of any such District, as the case may require, and upon such day as shall be fixed in

and by any such Proclamation, the part or parts therein specified shall be in force in and as to such Highway District, or with regard to the inhabitants, ratepayers, or governing body of such District, as the case may require.

And whereas the Auckland Provincial Council have, by Resolution dated the eighteenth day of December, 1871, recommended the Superintendent without delay, by Proclamation, to extend and apply the provisions of parts two, three, four, five, six, and seven of the said Act to all the existing Highway Districts of the Province.

Now therefore I, Joseph May, Deputy Superintendent of the Province of Auckland, in pursuance and in exercise of the power and authority for that purpose vested in me, and upon the recommendation of the Auckland Provincial Council, do hereby declare that all of the parts of the said Highway Boards Empowering Act, 1871, numbered two, three, four, five, six, and seven, shall extend and apply to the several Highway Districts specified in the Schedule hereunder, and shall be in force in and as to such Highway Districts respectively on and after the date of publication hereof.

A BY-LAW to restrain any person from riding or driving round an angle or corner of any street at other than a walking pace.

By-law of the Council of the City of Auckland made under special order of the said Council, dated the second day of June, 1873, confirmed and sealed with the Common Seal of the said Council, the thirtieth day of June, 1873.

In pursuance of "The Municipal Corporations Act, 1867," Part 13, Section 186, the Council of the City of Auckland ordain as follows that is to say—

Any person who shall drive any vehicle or ride any horse at other than a walking pace round an angle or corner of any Street in the City of Auckland shall for every such offence forfeit and pay upon conviction a penalty not exceeding Five Pounds.
