By the Central Board of Health for the Province of Auckland.

WHEREAS, under the twenty-fifth section of "The Public Health Act, 1872," it has been made to appear to the Central Board of Health, within the Province of Auckland, that the Local Board of the Newton Highway District, established within the said Province, has not caused the First Part of the said Act to be efficiently enforced within its jurisdiction, and that from such neglect or omission the health and comfort of the Inhabitants resident within such jurisdiction are liable to be affected.
