THE REMUERA HIGHWAY DISTRICT.

Amended Boundaries.

THIS District shall comprise all those lands bounded towards the north by high water mark of the sea from the seaward termination of the western boundary of allotment No. 40A of the parish of Waitemata to the Slaughterhouse creek, thence by the middle of said creek to the north side of the Grammar School road, thence by the north side of said road from the creek aforesaid to the east side of the Epsom road, on the west by the east side of Epsom road aforesaid, to the north-western angle of allotment No. 21 of section No. 4 of the suburbs of Auckland aforesaid thence by the north-eastern boundary of said allotment No. 21 to the Slaughterhouse creek aforesaid, thence by the said creek to the southern bound-

dary of allotment No. 23 of section and suburbs last named, and by said southern boundary to the eastern side of the Epsom road, thence by the eastern side of the Epsom road aforesaid to the Great South road; towards the south-west by the Great South road aforesaid, to the junction of roads at the Harp of Erin Inn, thence towards the south by a direct line from the junction of roads last named to the south-western angle of allotment No. 25 of section No. 12 of the suburbs aforesaid, and by the southern boundary of said allotment No. 25, and the southern boundary of allotment No. 34 of section No. 12 of suburbs aforesaid to its south-eastern angle; and towards the east by the eastern boundary of allotment No. 34 aforesaid to the Tamaki road at its north-eastern angle, thence by the south side of the Tamaki road aforesaid to the eastern boundary of section No. 16 of the suburbs of Auckland aforesaid, and thence by said eastern boundary of section No. 16 aforesaid, and the western boundary of allotment No. 40A of the parish of Waitemata first mentioned, to the place of commencement. Exclusive of the native cultivations within the Orakei Block, No. 1,338.
