PROCLAMATION.

By His Honour SIR GEORGE GREY, Knight
Commander of the Most Honourable
Order of the Bath, Superintendent of
the Province of Auckland.

WHEREAS by the nineteenth section of "The Auckland Waste Lands Act, 1874," it is enacted that "Reserves for the uses of the Provincial Government and for other public purposes of a specific character may, upon the recommendation of the Provincial Council, be made by the Superintendent out of any waste lands, and shall not be alienated from the specific purposes to which they shall have been severally dedicated except under the provisions of "The Public Reserves Act, 1854;" and a full and complete description of every such reserve, and of the purposes to which it shall have been dedicated, shall forthwith be published in the Provincial Government Gazette, and shall also be set forth in the authenticated maps in the Land Office."

AND WHEREAS by a letter dated the 16th April, 1875, addressed to the Superintendent of the Province of Auckland, the Honourable the Colonial Secretary did promise that he would direct the preparation of a Crown Grant to the Superintendent of the land mentioned and described in the schedule hereunder, upon receipt of the Gazette notice formally reserving the same for purposes of public recreation:

AND WHEREAS the Auckland Provincial Council, by resolution on the 27th May, 1875, did recommend the reservation of the said land "as a place for a public garden and for public recreation."

NOW THEREFORE, I do hereby, in pursuance of the nineteenth section of "The Auckland Waste Lands Act, 1874," above quoted, and upon the recommendation of the Auckland Provincial Council as aforesaid, reserve and dedicate the said land hereunder described to be a place for a public garden and for public recreation.

THE MOUNT ALBERT HIGHWAY DISTRICT.

Amended Boundaries.

Bounded towards the north by part of the northern boundary of section No. 5, of the suburbs of Auckland, from the north-western angle of allotment No. 35 of said section to the north-western angle of allotment No. 10, of section No 5 aforesaid, and continuing along the north-eastern boundary of allotment No. 10 to its easternmost angle; thence towards the east by a right line crossing the road known as the New North Road to the eastern side of the Mount Roskill Road, thence westerly, crossing the Mount Roskill Road aforesaid to its western side, and continuing southerly along said road to a line parallel to and at a distance of about 235 links from the road which forms the north-western boundary of allotment No. 11, of section No. 10 aforesaid, thence by said line westerly to the north-western angle of Mr. Baker's land, and continuing southerly along the western boundary of said land, and by the same boundary produced in a southerly direction to the northern boundary of allotment No. 136, also of section No. 10 of the suburbs of Auckland before mentioned, thence westerly by the northern boundary of allotment No. 136 aforesaid to the north-eastern angle of allotment No. 137, of section No. 10 aforesaid, thence by the eastern boundary of allotment No. 137 aforesaid and the eastern boundaries of allotments Nos. 138, 139, 140, 141, 142, 143, 144, 145, 146, and 178, of section No. 10 aforesaid, as also the eastern boundary of allotment No. 46 of the parish of Titirangi to its south-eastern angle; towards the south by the centre of the road which forms the south-western boundary of allotment No. 46 aforesaid, and the south-western boundaries of allotments Nos. 45 and 44, and part of the south-western boundary of allotment No. 43 to the road which forms the south-eastern boundary of allotment No. 50, thence by the centre of said road to a point, being a continuation of the north-eastern boundary of allotment No. 51, thence crossing the before-mentioned road, and by the north-eastern and south-eastern boundaries of allotment No. 51 aforesaid to the road which forms its south-western boundary, thence crossing said road, and by the south-eastern boundary of allotment No. 52 to the rivulet, thence westerly along said rivulet to the north-eastern boundary of allotment No. 65; towards the west by the rivulet aforesaid from the north-eastern angle of

said lot No. 65 to a line running parallel to and at a distance of three chains from the Southern side of the New North Road, thence by said line to the road which forms the eastern boundary of allotment No. 64, thence northerly by the centre of the said road to the southern boundary of allotment No. 62, thence easterly by said boundary to Oakley's stream, and by said stream to the south-western angle of allotment No. 32; and towards the north-west by the southern boundary of allotment No. 32 aforesaid to the road which forms its eastern boundary, thence crossing said road and by the southern and eastern boundaries of allotment No. 35 and the eastern boundary of allotment No. 29, all of the parish of Titirangi aforesaid to the Meola stream, thence by the said stream eastward to the south-western point of allotment No. 172 of section No. 10 of the suburbs of Auckland aforesaid, thence by the north-western and north-eastern boundaries of said allotment No. 172 to the road which forms its eastern boundary, thence northerly along the centre of said road to its junction with the road which forms the North-eastern boundaries of allotments Nos. 176 and 177, of said section No. 10, and continuing along the centre of said road to the south-western angle of allotment No. 37 of section No. 5 of the suburbs of Auckland aforesaid, thence by the western boundary of said allotment No. 37 and the western boundary of said allotments Nos. 36 and 35 of section No. 5 aforesaid to the point of commencement.

THE PAPARATA HIGHWAY DISTRICT.

Amended Boundaries.

Commencing at a point on the centre of the Great South Road at its junction with the road which traverses allotment No. 49 of the Parish of Opaheke bounded towards the north by a line from the centre of the Great South Road from the point last named to the southern side of the road which traverses allotment No. 49 of the Parish of Opaheke aforesaid thence by the southern side of said road which forms the northern boundaries of allotments Numbers 97, 96, 94, and 93 of small lots know as the Bombay Settlement and also the northern boundaries of allotments Numbers 163, 218 and 198 and continuing along the south side of said road to its junction with the road which forms the eastern boundary of allotment No. 164 thence crossing said road and continuing along its eastern side to the northern boundary of allotment No. 166 of the Parish of Opaheke aforesaid thence by the northern and part of the eastern boundaries of allotment No. 166 last named and the northern boundary of allotment No. 169 to the road which forms its eastern boundary thence southerly by the eastern side of said road to a point being the production in a westerly direction of the northern boundary of allotment No. 171 and crossing said road at the point last named to the north-western angle of allotment No. 171 aforesaid and by the northern boundary of allotment No. 171 the crossing of the road which forms its eastern boundary to the westernmost angle of allotment No. 172 thence by the eastern side of said road to the northernmost angle of allotment No. 172 aforesaid thence by the western side of the road which forms the north-eastern boundary of said lot No. 172 to its junction with the road which forms the northern boundary of allotment No. 107 of the

Parish of Maungatawhiri thence crossing the road which forms the eastern boundary of allotment No. 172 of the Parish of Opaheke aforesaid and continuing along the northern side of the road which forms the western boundary of allotment No. 107 of the Parish of Maungatawhiri aforesaid to the south-western angle of allotment No. 115 of the Parish of Opaheke aforesaid thence by the western and part of the northern boundary of allotment No. 115 last named and the western boundary of allotment No. 118 also of the parish of Opaheke aforesaid to the southern side of the road which forms its northern boundary thence by the southern side of said road to the south-eastern angle of allotment No. 118 aforesaid, thence by part of the southern boundary of allotment No. 118 last-named and the eastern boundary of allotment No. 116 of the Parish of Opaheke aforesaid to the road which forms the southern boundary of allotment No. 117 of the parish last named, thence by the northern and western sides of said road which form the southern and western boundaries of allotment No. 117 aforesaid and also form part of the eastern boundary of allotment No. 90 to the northern boundary of allotment No. 131 of the Parish of Opaheke aforesaid, thence crossing said road and by the northern boundary of allotment No. 131 the crossing of a road one hundred links wide and the northern boundary of allotment No. 132 to the road which forms the western boundary of the last-named lot, thence southerly by the western side of said road to a point being the production in a westerly direction of the southern boundary of allotment No. 13, all of the Parish of Otau aforesaid; thence crossing said road and continuing along the southern and eastern boundaries of allotment No. 13, last-named, and the eastern boundary of allotment No. 12, also of the Parish of Otau aforesaid, to the north-eastern angle of last-named lot; towards the north-east by a right line in a south-easterly direction from the north-eastern boundary of allotment No. 12, of the Parish of Otau aforesaid, to the Maungatawhiri River; towards the south-east by the Maungatawhiri River aforesaid to the north-western boundary of allotment No. 35, of the Parish of Otau, thence by the north-western and south-western boundaries of allotment No. 35, and the north-western boundary of allotment No. 1, also of the Parish of Otau before-mentioned, the crossing of a road 100 links wide, the southern boundary of allotment number 142, of the Parish of Maungatawhiri, to the road which forms its south-western boundary; towards the south by the northern side of said road to the south-eastern angle of allotment No. 116, of the Parish of Maungatawhiri aforesaid, thence by the north-eastern, north-western, and south-western boundaries of allotment No. 116 aforesaid, to the road at its south-western angle, thence by the northern side of said road to the north-eastern boundary of allotment No. 114, also of the Parish of Maungatawhiri aforesaid, thence by the north-eastern and north-western boundaries of allotment No. 114 last-named, and by said last-named boundary produced to the centre of the road which forms its south-western boundary, thence northerly by the centre of said road to the south-eastern angle of allotment No. 102, of the Parish of Maungatawhiri aforesaid, thence by a right line due south to the southern side of said road, thence westerly by the southern side of said road to the eastern boundary of allotment No. 103, and by the eastern and southern boundaries of allotment No. 103 aforesaid to the road at its south-western angle, thence southerly by the eastern side of said road to a point being the production in an easterly direction

of the northern boundary of allotment No. 171, thence crossing said road at the place last described and following the northern boundary of allotment No. 171 aforesaid to the road which forms its north-western boundary, and continuing southerly along the eastern side of said road to the south-western angle of allotment No. 169, thence crossing said road and continuing along the northern boundary of allotment No. 168, and part of the eastern and the whole of the northern boundary of allotment No. 156 to the road at the north-western angle of last-named lot, thence crossing said road and continuing northerly along its western side to its junction with the road which forms the north-western boundary of allotment No. 147, thence continuing westerly by the western side of said road to its junction with the road which forms the northern boundary of said allotment No. 147, thence by the southern side of said road to the north-western angle of allotment No. 20 of suburban section No. 2 of the Parish of Maungatawhiri, thence crossing said road and continuing northerly along its western side to the northern boundary of allotment No. 18, also of suburban section No. 2, of the Parish of Maungatawhiri aforesaid, thence by the northern boundary of allotment No. 18 aforesaid, the northern boundary of allotment No. 13 and said last-named boundary produced to the centre of the Great South Road; and towards the south-west by the centre of the Great South Road to its junction with the road which traverses allotment No. 49 of the Parish of Opaheke first-mentioned, the place of commencement.

THE POKENO HIGHWAY DISTRICT.

Amended Boundaries.

Commencing at a point on the centre of the Great South Road being the termination of a right line produced in a westerly direction in continuance of the northern boundary of allotment number 13 of section number 2 of the Parish of Maungatawhiri; bounded towards the north by the line before-mentioned by the northern boundary of allotment number 13 aforesaid the northern boundary of allotment number 18 and the crossing of a road 100 links wide to the north-western angle of allotment number 20 of section number 2 of the Parish of Maungatawhiri aforesaid, thence by the south side of the road which forms the northern boundary of allotment number 20 last named and continuing easterly along said road to the road which forms the eastern boundary of allotment number 147 of the Parish of Maungatawhiri, thence continuing southerly along the western side of said road to a point being the continuation of the north-western boundary of allotment number 156 of the Parish of Maungatawhiri aforesaid, thence crossing said road and continuing along the north-western and part of the north-eastern boundaries of allotment number 156 aforesaid and the northern boundary of allotment number 168 also of the Parish of Maungatawhiri to the road which forms the western boundary of allotment number 169, thence crossing said road and continuing northerly along its eastern side to the northern boundary of allotment number 171, thence by the northern boundary of allotment number 171 aforesaid to the road which forms the eastern boundary of allotment number

104 of the Parish of Maungatawhiri aforesaid and crossing said road and continuing northerly along its eastern side to the northern boundary of allotment number 104 aforesaid, thence by the northern boundary of allotment number 104 aforesaid and the eastern boundary of allotment number 103 to the road which forms the northern boundary of the last-named lot, thence easterly along the south side of said road to a point opposite the south-eastern angle of allotment number 102 of the Parish of Maungatawhiri aforesaid, thence by a right line to the centre of said road and continuing south-easterly along its centre to a line being the production in a westerly direction of the north-western boundary of allotment number 114, thence by said line and by the north-western and north-eastern boundaries of allotment number 114 last named to the road which forms its south-eastern boundary, thence by the northern side of said road, the south-western, north-western, and north-eastern boundaries of allotment number 116 to the road at its south-eastern angle, thence following the northern side of said road to the southern boundary of allotment number 142 and by the southern boundary of allotment number 142 aforesaid, the crossing of a road one hundred links wide, part of the north-western boundary of allotment number 1 of the Parish of Otau, and the south-western and north-western boundaries of allotment number 35 of last-named parish to the Maungatawhiri River, and continuing northerly along the Maungatawhiri River to the north-eastern boundary of allotment number 34 of the Parish of Otau aforesaid, towards the north-east by the north-eastern boundary of allotment number 34 of the Parish of Otau aforesaid, and a right line thence to the Confiscation boundary at a point where it joins the south side of the road which forms the southern boundary of allotment number 36 of the Parish last named, thence by said Confiscation boundary line to the northern boundary of allotment number 39 of the Parish of Koheroa, thence westerly by said boundary to the north-western angle of allotment number 39 last named, and continuing along the western boundary of said allotment number 39 to the centre of the Pukorokoro Road, towards the south-east by the centre of the Pukorokoro Road aforesaid to the south-eastern boundary of allotment number 37 of the Parish of Koheroa aforesaid, thence by the south-eastern and part of the south-western boundaries of said allotment number 37 to the centre of the Pukorokoro Road before mentioned, and continuing thence along the centre of said road to its junction with the Great South Road, and towards the south-west by the Great South Road to the production of the northern boundary of allotment number 13 of section number 2 of the Parish of Maungatawhiri first mentioned, the place of commencement.
