BY-LAW No. 17.

BY-LAW of the Council of the City of Auckland, made under Special Order of the said Council, dated the Fifth day of July, One thousand eight hundred and seventy-five, confirmed and sealed with the Common Seal of the said Council the Sixteenth day of August, One thousand eight hundred and seventy-five.

In pursuance of Section 181 of Part 13 of "The Municipal Corporations Act, 1867," the Council of the City of Auckland ordain as follows: that is to say:—

Part 2 and Subdivisions 1 and 2 of part 4 of the 13th Schedule to the said Act are hereby adopted in and for the said City.
