## PUBLIC NOTIFICATION.

By His Honour SIR GEORGE GREY, Knight Commander of the Most Honourable Order of the Bath, Superintendent of the Province of Auckland.

WHEREAS by an Act made and passed by the Superintendent of the Province of Auckland, with the advice and consent of the Provincial Council thereof, intituled "The Auckland Municipal Police Act, 1866," it is amongst other things enacted that the Superintendent may from time to time, by Public Notification in the Provincial Government *Gazette*, appoint and define the limits of cities, towns, and other places, within the Province of Auckland, for the purposes of this Act:

Now therefore I, the Superintendent of the Province of Auckland, pursuant to the authority vested in me in that behalf, do hereby proclaim and declare that for the purposes of the said "Auckland Municipal Police Act, 1866," the limits of the TOWN of WHANGAREI within which the said Act shall from the date hereof come into force, shall comprise all that block of land situated within the Parish of

Whangarei, County of Marsden, and included within a radius of one mile from the Whangarei Post-Office.
