## PROCLAMATION.

**BY** virtue of the powers in me vested by section 83, of "The Auckland Waste Lands Act, 1874," I do hereby make the following Regulations for the imposition of penalties for breaches of the Regulations for granting Water Rights under Part VII of the said Act:—

1. Every person committing any breach of the said Regulations, or of any part thereof, shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding Twenty Pounds (£20).

2. Every person failing to comply with the conditions of any Water Right under the said Regulations, or with any part thereof, shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding Twenty Pounds (£20).
