THE MAUNU HIGHWAY DISTRICT.

Amended Boundaries.

Bounded towards the north by the southern boundaries of the Ruatangata, Mirowhakatiki and Maruarua blocks from the Wairua river to the south-eastern angle of the last-named block, thence by a right line to the westernmost angle of the Whau Whau block, and continuing along the southern boundary of the Whau Whau block aforesaid to its south-easternmost angle, thence by part of the south-western boundary of Dr. Perston's land known as Ratu, and also by the southern and eastern boundaries of Dr. Perston's land to the mouth of the Waiarohia river; towards the east by the waters of Whangarei harbour from the mouth of the Waiarohia river aforesaid to the seaward termination of the southern boundary of the Maungatapere block; towards the south by the southern boundary of the Maungatapere block aforesaid and a right line to the Wairua river aforesaid: and towards the west by the Wairua river to the point of commencement.

THE WANGAREI HIGHWAY DISTRICT.

Amended Boundaries.

Bounded towards the north by the centre of the Waitaua River from the north-western angle of the land known as Meldrum's claim to its confluence with the Hatea river; towards the east by the centre of the Hatea river aforesaid to a line being the production in an easterly direction of the northern side of the upper landing-place; towards the south-east by said line by the northern side of the upper landing-place aforesaid and the northern side of the road leading from the upper landing-place aforesaid to the eastern side of the Mill road, thence crossing the road leading to the upper landing-place aforesaid and continuing along the eastern side of the Mill road aforesaid to a point opposite to the centre of the road leading through the late Mr. Gorrie's property, thence crossing the Bay of Islands road and by the centre of the road leading through the property of the late Mr. Gorrie aforesaid to the centre of the road which forms the south-western boundary of the property of the late Mr. Gorrie aforesaid and by the centre of the said last-named road to the Waiarohia river, thence by the centre of the Waiarohia river aforesaid to a line being the production in an easterly direction of the northern boundary of Mr. Hunt's land known as Wycombe, thence by said line and by part of the northern boundary of Mr. Hunt's land aforesaid to the western boundary of said land, thence southerly by part of the western boundary of Mr. Hunt's land aforesaid to the north-western boundary of Dr. Perston's land known as Ratu, thence by the north-western boundary of Dr. Perston's land aforesaid to the eastern boundary of the Whau Whau block, thence south-easterly by part of the eastern boundary of the Whau Whau block aforesaid to the south-eastern angle of the Whau Whau block last-named and by part of the southern boundary of the Whau Whau block aforesaid to its southernmost angle; towards the south-west by the south-western boundary of the Whau Whau block

aforsaid; towards the north-west by the north-western and northern boundaries of the Whau Whau block aforsaid and towards the west by part of the western boundary of Mair's Grant and the western boundaries of the Kamo block and the land known as Meldrum's grant first mentioned to the north-western angle of Meldrum's grant aforsaid, the place of commencement.

Coal Field, Parish of Pepepe, near Ngaruawahia.

Advertised for sale, for the first time, on the 13th July, 1872, at which time it was unsurveyed.

Fact of its containing coal not mentioned in the notification. Mr. Sinclair states that it was afterwards withdrawn and not offered for sale. It is erased in the office copy of the *Gazette* in the Confiscated Land Department

A second time advertised for sale in the *New Zealand Gazette*, of the 1st November, 1872, and offered for sale on the 3rd December, 1872. It is then described as "containing coal." No buyer at the auction.

In both notifications the area of the lot is stated to be 10,000 acres, but on survey, which would appear to have been subsequently made and completed on the 26th November, 1872, it was ascertained to contain 9,850 acres.

At the auction sale, of the 3rd December, 1872, it was offered as containing 10,000 acres, and at the upset price of £3,750, or at the rate of 7s. 6d. per acre. On the 2nd October, 1873, it was selected by Messrs. Whitaker, Russell, and others, as containing 9,850 acres, for the price of £3,693.

In the schedule to the first notification it is found to be inserted among 128 rural allotments, the average area of which is about 31 acres, the average upset price being about 17s. 3d. per acre.

In the second schedule it appears with 20 other rural allotments, averaging about 61 acres each; average upset price, 11s. per acre.

NOTE—Under "The Auckland Mineral Leases Act, 1871," (14th November,) the minimum and maximum areas allowed to be granted, by way of lease, are fixed at 100 acres and 640 acres for coal land respectively.

(Telegram.) Wellington, 23rd June, 1876.

I MADE the following statement in House:—
