50	William Du Moulin ... ..	20,000	Westward of Mount Peel, bounded on the North by the Rangitata River, on the East by Mount Peel, on the South by the Orari, and on the West by the Rangitata.
51	John Studholme ... ..	10,000	On the Waihao River, bounded on the North by the River Hook, on the South by the River Waihao, on the West by the Run No. 39, held by Studholme brothers, and on the East by a line parallel to the Western boundary to contain 10,000 acres.
52	Rev. John Raven, and T. K. Adams ... ..	40,000	On the River Nawai, bounded on the North by the Nawai, on the East by Runs held by Messrs. Burke, R. H. Rhodes, and W. B. Rhodes, on the West by the Snowy Range, and on the South to the extent of 40,000 acres.
