WHEREAS a Writ under the hand of James Edward Fitz Gerald, Esq., Superintendent of the said Province, bearing date the 8th day of January, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty-seven, hath been directed to me, Charles Christopher Bowen, Esq., as Returning-Officer for the Christchurch Country District, in the said Province, requiring and commanding me to cause to be elected, by and from amongst the voters duly qualified for that purpose, freely and indifferently, and in form and manner by law prescribed, *One Person* to serve as a member of the Provincial Council for the Christchurch Country District, in the place of William Bayley Bray, Esq., resigned; NOW therefore, I, the said Charles Christopher Bowen, Esq., Returning-Officer for the Christchurch Country District, do hereby, in pursuance of the said recited Writ, give notice that a

The voting to commence at any time after nine o'clock of the said day, and to close at four o'clock, P.M. of the same day.
