I, William Sefton Moorhouse, Superinten-
dent of the Province of Canterbury, by
virtue of the powers vested in me by the
43rd clause of the Waste Lands Regula-
tions now in force within the said Province,
do hereby reserve from sale until the 30th
September next ensuing, the several portions
of land hereinafter described, that is to
say:—

One hundred and ten acres in the Mandeville District, having frontage to and being bounded on the North-west by a road north-west of Section 3064; on the South-west by said Section; on the North-east by Section 1225, and a line parallel to the South-west boundary, so as to include the above quantity, and on the South-east by a line parallel to the North-western boundary.

Forty acres in the Mandeville District, bounded on the North by Pre-emptive Right, No. 53; on the South-east by Sections Nos. 3129, 3141, 3142; 3143, 3144, and 3169; on the South-west by Section 3919 (32 acres); and on the North-west by a line parallel to the South-western boundary, so as to include the above quantity.
