PROCLAMATION,

WHEREAS, by an Act bearing date the Sixth day of August, One Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty-six, passed by the Governor of the Colony of New Zealand, by and with the consent of the General Assembly, intituled "An Act to make provision for the performance of the duties of the Superintendent during the temporary absence of any such Superintendent, and during vacancies in the office." It is enacted, *inter alia*, that it shall be lawful for the Superintendent of any Province, by Proclamation, to be published in the "Government Gazette" of such Province, to appoint such person as he may think fit, being a registered elector of such Province, to be his Deputy. Now therefore I, William Sefton Moorhouse, the Superintendent of the Province of Canterbury, in the said Colony, in pursuance of the powers and authority in me vested by the said in part recited Act, do hereby appoint

ROBERT WILKIN, Esquire,
being a registered elector of the said Province, to be Deputy-Superintendent.
