PROCLAMATION

By JAMES A. R. MENZIES, Esq., *Superintendent of the Province of Southland.*

**W**HEREAS His Excellency the Governor in Council has been pleased to delegate to the Superintendent of the Pro-

vince of Southland, certain powers under the "Diseased Cattle Act, 1861," and whereas by Proclamation dated the 10th and 26th days of December, 1831, respectively, published in the Southland Provincial Government Gazette, it is amongst other things declared, that the Inspector of Cattle in the Province of Southland, under the provisions of the said Act, shall not be authorized to grant a certificate to land, in the Province of Southland, Cattle coming from Tasmania. And whereas it is expedient to revoke the provision and make other provision in lieu thereof:

Now therefore I, the said Superintendent, in virtue of the power in me vested, do hereby proclaim that the Inspector of Cattle is hereby authorized to grant certificates to land, in the Province of Southland, Cattle coming from Tasmania, always provided that such Cattle shall be free from the disease called Pleuro Pneumonia; and that the owner or person in charge of such Cattle shall have previously given to such Inspector satisfactory proof that the Cattle sought to be landed were bred in Tasmania, or were depastured in Tasmania for six consecutive months prior to their last embarkation from thence.
