PROCLAMATION.

By His Honor SAMUEL BEALEY, Esq.,
Superintendent of the Province of
Canterbury.

WHEREAS by an Ordinance enacted by the Superintendent and Provincial Council of the Province of Canterbury, intitled "The Education Ordinance, 1864," it is among other things provided that the Superintendent shall, as soon as conveniently may be after the passing of the said Ordinance, proclaim such districts as Educational Districts as shall include one or more of the schools already established, and that thereupon such districts shall be deemed to be Educational Districts within the meaning of the said Ordinance.

Now, therefore, I, the Superintendent of the said Province, in pursuance of the power and authority in me vested by the said in part recited Ordinance, do hereby proclaim that the districts specified in the schedule hereunto annexed shall be Educational Districts within the meaning of the said Ordinance.

SCHEDULE.

LEITHFIELD DISTRICT.

Bounded on the eastward by the sea; on the north-eastward by the gully running through section 2758 to the North Road; thence by a right line to the south-east corner of section 2883; thence along the road to the south side of said section to the railway reserve; thence by that reserve southerly to the southern bank of the South Kowai, following westerly along the said bank to the north-west corner of section 3984, following south-easterly along the road forming the south-western boundary of that section to the terrace road, following along the Brown's Bridge Road to the North Road; thence by that road to the road south of trig. pole 7 running to the beach, and thence by the last-mentioned road to the sea.

ASHLEY BANK DISTRICT.

Bounded on the southward by the River Ashley; on the westward by the Makerikiri; on the northward by a line drawn through trig. poles 2 and 3a, and a line from trig. pole 3a to the northernmost corner of section 2885; thence by Stony Creek to where it is intersected by the southern side of the Upper Sefton Road; thence by that road to the road on the north-east side of section 2137; thence by that road to the north-west corner of the town of Sefton; and thence by the western boundary thereof, and the road on the west side of section 1976, to the River Ashley aforesaid.

WOODEND DISTRICT.

Bounded on the westward by the Rangiora District and the native reserve to Lee's

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Road; thence by Lee's Road to the eastern boundary of section 779; and thence by a right line through trig. station M 2 to the sea; thence by the sea to the River Ashley; and thence by that river to the eastern boundary of the Rangiora District aforesaid.

RANGIORA DISTRICT.

Commencing at the cross roads near Fernside; thence following the road on the north-west side of section 4107 to the River Ashley; thence easterly along the southern bank of the said river to the eastern boundary of section 1271, following southerly along that boundary to the south-eastern corner thereof; thence following a right line to trig. station M 16; thence by the road on the north-western boundary of the native reserve to the River Cam, following the western side of that river to the road by trig. pole 17, following south-westerly along the said road to the road on the north-east side of section 1220; thence south-easterly along the north-eastern boundary of said section to the main drain reserve, following north-westerly along that reserve to the road on the north-west side of section 2865, and returning in a northerly direction along that road and the road west of section 4790 to the commencing point.

KAIAPOI DISTRICT.

Bounded on the eastward by the sea; on the south by a right line drawn through trig. stations 25 and 221; thence by the south bank of the Waimakariri to a point opposite to its junction with the Kaikanui Creek; thence across the Waimakariri to the aforesaid junction, following the said creek to the point where it intersects the southern boundary of section 321, following along the southern and western boundaries of sections 321 and 425, and the southern boundary of section 395 to the southern bank of the north branch of the Waimakariri; thence northerly and easterly along that branch to a point in line with the eastern boundary of section 338c, following along the said boundary and a line in continuation thereof to the River Cam; thence following along that river to a point due west of the north-west corner of section 1822; thence by a straight line to the said north-west corner of section 1822; and thence by the southern boundary of the Woodend District to the sea, exclusive of the native reserve.

NORTH ROAD DISTRICT.

Bounded on the westward by the Harewood Road District; on the southward by the Papanui District and the road on the northwest side of section 1472, the southern and part of the south-eastern boundaries of section 1479, and the northern boundary line of sections 4593 and 2431, and a line in continuation of the last-mentioned boundary till it reaches the sea; on the eastward by the sea; on the northward by the Kaiapoi District; and on the north-west by the Waimakariri.

PAPANUI DISTRICT.

Commencing at the southernmost corner of section 276, on the North Road, following along the northern boundary of the St. Alban's District; thence following easterly along the road on the south side of sections 1052 and 1139 to the canal reserve, following northerly along the said reserve to the Purarikanui stream, following westerly along the said stream to the North Road, following southerly along that road to the road passing through section 293, following westerly along the said road to the road west of section 533a, following along that road to the Harewood Road by Papanui, following north-westerly along the said road to the north-western corner of section 330; thence following along the western boundary of that section and the south-western boundary line of the same section and section 323 to the southernmost corner of the latter section, following north-easterly along the south-eastern boundary of that section to section 151; thence following along the south-western boundaries of sections 151, 135, 299, 142, and 133, to the road on the north-west side of section 7, following along that road and that portion of it on the south-east side of section 133 to the North Road before mentioned, and from thence returning along the said road to the commencing point.

HAREWOOD ROAD DISTRICT.

Commencing at a point on the southern bank of the River Courtenay, the same being in line with the north-eastern boundary of section 2486, following south-easterly along that boundary and the north-eastern boundary of section 4827 to the road on the western side of section 533a, following southerly along that road to the Harewood Road by Papanui, following north-westerly along said road to the north-western corner of section 330, following along the western boundary thereof and along the southern boundary of section 140 to the continuation of the road east of section 2457, following southerly along the said road to the northern boundary of section 199, following westerly along the northern boundaries of sections 199, 2710, and 3282, to the road on the west side of the last-mentioned sections, following southerly along that road to the road forming the southern boundary of section 1725; thence northwesterly along that road to the road on the north-west side of section 5523, following along that road to the Harewood Road by Papanui above mentioned, following westerly along the said Harewood Road to the south-western corner of section 6347, following northerly along the western boundary thereof to the river Courtenay aforesaid, and from thence returning along the said river to the commencing point.

ST. ALBAN'S DISTRICT.

Commencing at the intersection of the Town Belt by the North Road; following northwesterly along the said road to the southernmost corner of section 276; thence along the south-eastern boundary of that

section to the south-western boundary of section 1048; thence following along the south-western and south-eastern boundaries of that section and the south-eastern boundary of section 781, to the road north-east of the last mentioned section; following south-easterly and easterly along the south-western and southern boundaries of section 1071, to the road on the east side of section 2256; following southerly along that road and the eastern boundary of section 287 to the road on the north side of section 33; following westerly and southerly along the said road to the Town Belt before mentioned; and from thence returning along the same to the commencing point.

TOWN OF CHRISTCHURCH DISTRICT.

The Town of Christchurch, as delineated on the map of the Chief Surveyor of the Province of Canterbury, setting out and describing the said town, and including the town reserves.

RICCARTON DISTRICT.

Bounded on the west by the Templeton District; the north-west boundary line of sections 1223, 1209, 1236, 1089, 1714, and 3282; following along the Wairerapa to the road west of section 188; following southerly along that road to the Waimairi Stream; thence easterly along that stream to the road separating section 163 from section 12; following southerly along that road to the road on the northern side of the stream running through section 163; following southerly along that road to the Harewood Road by Riccarton; following easterly along said road to the road east of section 78; following southerly along the western side of said road, and a line in continuation thereof, to the south-eastern boundary of section 145; following south-westerly along that boundary and the north-western boundary of section 159 to the Lincoln and Riccarton Junction Road, following north-westerly along that road to the road south-east of section 211; following south-westerly along that road to the northern boundary of the Halswell District; thence westerly along that district till it meets the Prebbleton District; thence north-westerly along the north-eastern boundary of the last mentioned district to the Templeton District, and from thence following along that district to the commencing point.

TEMPLETON DISTRICT.

Commencing at the intersection of the south-western side of the old river bed by the road north-west of section 1768; following north-easterly along the said road to another road on the west side of section 4447; following northerly along that road and the western boundaries of sections 1305 and 1490 to section 1155; following south-easterly and north-easterly along the south-western and south-eastern bodies of that section to the Harewood Road, by Riccarton; following north-westerly along that road to the road on the north-west side

of section 1226; following north-easterly along that road to the Harewood Road, by Riccarton; following westerly along that road and Bealey's Road to the road on the south-west side of section 5835; following southerly along that road to the north-west boundary of the Prebbleton District, and following along that boundary to the commencing point.

PREBBLETON DISTRICT.

Bounded on the eastward by the western boundary of the Halswell District and the old river bed; on the southward by the Halswell Road, by Ladbrooke's, the northern boundary of section 3745, and a line drawn to the easternmost corner of section 3868; on the north-west by a straight line from the said corner to the westernmost corner of 4257; thence by the back boundaries of sections 4257, 3956, 3850, 3763, 3115, 3732, 6437, 2784, 2709, 3729, 2837, 2586, 2628, 2636, 2783, 2678, 2587, a straight line drawn from the northern corner of the last mentioned section to the northern corner of section 2652, and by the southern and eastern boundaries of section 1948 to the South Road, and thence by the South Road to the old river bed above mentioned.

UPPER HEATHCOTE DISTRICT.

Bounded on the north-west by the Riccarton District, and on the south-west by the Halswell District; on the south-east by south-east boundary lines of sections 310, 315, 340, 243c, 147, and a straight line drawn from the south-eastern corner of the last mentioned section to the south-eastern corner of section 72; following along the eastern boundary of that section to the Town Belt; thence westerly along the Town Belt, and northerly along Hagley Park to the south-eastern corner of section No. 10; thence following westerly along the southern boundary of that section, and a line in continuation thereof, and the southern boundaries of sections 155 and 153a, to the Riccarton District above mentioned.

HALSWELL DISTRICT.

Commencing at the south-eastern corner of section 198 on the Lincoln Road, following along the north-eastern boundary thereof to the watercourse on the south side of section 346, following westerly along that watercourse to the north-eastern corner of section 1246, following along the south-eastern and part of the south-western boundary thereof to the north-eastern corner of section 1511, following along the south-eastern boundary of that section to the south-eastern corner, thence following a right line to the road on the north-west side of section 867, following south-westerly along the said road and the north-west boundary of section 952 to the dry river-bed of the Halswell, following southerly along the said river-bed and the Halswell River to the easternmost corner of section 1027, following south-westerly along the south-eastern boundary thereof to a tributary of the aforesaid river, following

the said tributary to the south-west corner of section 1106, thence following a straight line to the source of the stream forming the eastern boundary of section 1882, following the said stream to the aforesaid River Halswell, thence along the said river to the easternmost corner of section 597, thence following a right line to Cooper's Knobs, thence northerly along the ridge of the Port Lyttelton Hills to the top of the Hoon Hay Valley, following the eastern side of the said valley to the south-western corner of section 1944, and from thence returning in a straight line to the commencing point.

LINCOLN DISTRICT.

Commencing at a point on Shand's Road, the same being the north-western corner of section 3650, following easterly along the southern boundary of the Prebbleton District to the western boundary of the Halswell District, following southerly along the last mentioned boundary to the River Halswell, following down the said river to the south-eastern corner of sections 4711 and 4821, following westerly and northerly along the southern and western boundaries of those sections, and a line in continuation of the last mentioned boundary to the north-eastern corner of section 5747, following westerly along the northern boundary line of that section and of sections 5941, 6072, 6134, 6238, and 6873, thence following a straight line to the south-eastern corner of section 6306, following westerly the southern boundary of that section and a line in continuation of the same to the Springs Road, following northerly along that road to the north-east corner of section 2951, following westerly along the northern boundary thereof to the Weedon and Springs Road, following north-westerly along that road to its junction with Shand's Road before mentioned, and from thence returning along that road to the starting point.

LOWER HEATHCOTE DISTRICT.

Commencing at Wilson's Bridge on the River Heathcote, following down that river to the bridge at the Ferry, thence following the estuary of that river to the north-eastern corner of section 15, thence along the north-eastern boundary of that section and of sections 27, 28, 34, 39, 42, 131, 103, 101, 99, 88, and 84, thence southerly following the road on the north-west side of the last mentioned section to the north-eastern corner of section 69, following westerly along the northern boundary thereof to the Town Belt, following southerly along the said belt to the Ferry road, thence south-easterly along the Ferry Road to the Hills Road, and from thence returning along the said road to the starting point.

HEATHCOTE VALLEY DISTRICT.

Commencing at the north-eastern corner of section 245 on the River Heathcote, following easterly along the southern bank of that river to trig. pole 14, thence following

the top of the spur on the east of sections 1161 and 1163 to the ridge of the Port Lyttelton Hills, following westerly along said ridge to a point being in line with the eastern boundary line of section 1012, thence following a straight line to the south-eastern corner of section 1012, and from thence returning along the eastern boundary of that section, the southern boundary of section 248, and the eastern boundary line of sections 248 and 245 to the commencing point.

TOWN OF LYTTELTON DISTRICT.

The Town of Lyttelton, as delineated on the map of the Chief Surveyor of the Province of Canterbury, setting out and describing the said town, and including the town reserves.

GOVERNOR'S BAY DISTRICT.

Commencing at a point on the Kaituna Pass Road, the same being the northernmost corner of section 1337, following southerly along that road to the ridge of the hills, following westerly along said ridge by McQueen's Pass and Gebbie's Pass to the ridge by Cooper's Knobs and Cass' Peak, following northerly and north-easterly along that ridge to the Dyer's Pass Road, following southerly along that road and the creek running through section 226 to the sea, and from thence returning along the sea beach to the starting point.

DUVAUCHELLE'S BAY DISTRICT.

Bounded on the southward by the ridge of hills separating French Farm Bay from Barry's Bay, Akaroa Harbour, and a straight line drawn through trig. pole 17 to the road which passes through section 922, thence by that road to the ridge of the hills round Akaroa Harbour and on the north-eastward northward, and north-westward by that ridge.

AKAROA DISTRICT.

Bounded on the northward by the Duvau-chelle's Bay District, on the eastward by the continuation of the ridge of the hills forming the north-eastern boundary of that district, on the westward by Akaroa Harbour, and on the southward by the Onuku Native Reserve and a line in continuation of the northern boundary of the said reserve to the ridge of the hills before mentioned.

OKAIN'S BAY DISTRICT.

Bounded on the north and north-east by the sea, on the north-west by the ridge dividing Stony Bay from Okain's Bay; on the south-west by the south-western boundary of section 1910, and a line in continuation thereof; and on the south-east by a right line drawn from the southernmost corner of that section to Pah Point.

AROWHENUA DISTRICT.

Commencing at the junction of the South Road, with the road passing through section

4656, following easterly along the latter road to the sea beach, following the beach to the mouth of the River Ophihi, following westerly along that river to the south-west corner of section 6384, following north-westerly along the south-western boundary of that section, of section 2945 and section 3698 to the road on the north-west side of the last-mentioned section; following north-easterly and north-westerly along that road to the south-western corner of section 6595, and from thence returning in a straight line to the commencing point.

TIMARU DISTRICT.

Commencing at a point on the Watarakao Lagoon, where it is joined by the southern

side of the Washdyke Creek, following along the edge of the lagoon and the stream running therefrom into the sea; thence southerly along the beach to the Pig-hunting Creek; following westerly along said creek to where it intersects the western boundary of section 3753; following along that boundary to the Otipua Creek; following westerly along that creek the western boundaries of sections 6858 and 6859, the southern boundaries of sections 6582 and 7024; thence following a straight line from the westernmost corner of the last-mentioned sections to the source of the creek first mentioned, and from thence returning along the same to the commencing point.
