HIS Honor the Superintendent directs it to be notified that he has made the following Reserves, temporarily, under the 19th clause of the Waste Land Regulations; viz.—

No. 703, in red.—Four acres and six perches, more or less, situate in the Township of Greymouth, bounded on the north by Gresson Street, on the south by Swainson Street, on the south-east by Boundary Street, and

on the west by Arney Street—For the uses of the Provincial Government, and particularly for Police purposes.

No. 704, in red.—One acre one rood and eight perches, more or less, situate in the Township of Greymouth, commencing at a point on the west side of Arney Street, the same being the south-eastern corner of section No. 96, following the said street in a southerly direction a distance of two hundred links, and extending back westerly a distance of six hundred and fifty links, in a rectangular block, being bounded on the west by Chapman Street—For the uses of the Roman Catholic Church.
