- No. 737, in red.—Nine hundred acres, more or less, situate in the Ashburton District, bounded on the south-east by the road north-west of sections 6774 and 6773, and by section 8426, on the south-west by sections 8420 to 8423, on the north-west by the road north of the last-mentioned sections for a distance of about sixty-eight chains fifty links, and on the north-east by a line parallel to the south-western boundary of this reserve.
