PROCLAMATION

By His Honor WILLIAM SEFTON MOORHOUSE, Esq., Superintendent of the Province of Canterbury, postponing meeting of Provincial Council.

WHEREAS on the Tenth day of September, One thousand eight hundred and sixty-six, a Proclamation was issued in the Government Gazette of the Province of Canterbury, summoning the Provincial Council of the said Province to meet for the dispatch of business at the Council Chamber, Christchurch, at two o'clock in the afternoon of Friday, the Fifth day of October, One thousand eight hundred and sixty-six: And whereas it has been made to appear to me to be expedient that the said meeting of the Provincial Council should be postponed:

Now, therefore, I, WILLIAM SEFTON MOORHOUSE, Superintendent of the Province of Canterbury, in pursuance of the powers vested in me in that behalf, do hereby postpone the said meeting of the Provincial Council; and I do hereby appoint FRIDAY, the Nineteenth day of October, One thousand eight hundred and sixty-six, at Two o'clock in the afternoon, as the day and hour when such meeting shall take place.
