**PROCLAMATION.**

**W**HEREAS by an Ordinance of the Superintendent and Provincial Council of the Province of Canterbury, entitled "The Roads Ordinance, 1869," it is *inter alia* enacted that if at any time the Rate-payers of a district shall refuse or neglect to elect Members of the Board, or if the Members of the Board shall refuse or neglect to carry the said Ordinance into operation, the Superintendent, with the advice of the Executive Council, by Proclamation in the *Provincial Government Gazette*, shall declare the powers of such Board to be suspended, and shall, by Proclamation, appoint a Commissioner for such district, and thereupon all the powers, rights, privileges, and duties of such Board shall from the date of such Proclamation vest in and be exercised by such Commissioner on behalf of the Board:

And whereas the Road Board for the Malvern District has neglected to carry out the provisions of the said Ordinance:

Now, therefore, I, ROBERT HEATON RHODES, Deputy-Superintendent of the Province of Canterbury, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in me, and with

the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby proclaim the powers of the said Road Board to be suspended, and I appoint

THOMAS H. ANSON,

of Mount Torlesse, to be the Commissioner for the said district.
