KNOW All Men By These Presents that I, CROFT AUGUSTUS MARSACK, of Christchurch, in the Province of Canterbury, in New Zealand, Gentleman, being seized in fee simple of that part of Rural Section numbered 235 on the Map of the Chief Surveyor of the said Province of Canterbury, setting out and describing the rural land in the Christchurch district thereof, commencing at a point being the south-east corner of Rural Section 79; continuing thence westerly along the southern boundary of the said section 79 a distance of thirty-nine chains thirty-five links; thence at a right angle southerly a distance of forty links; thence again at a right angle easterly a distance of thirty-nine chains thirty-five links; thence at a right angle northerly a distance of forty links to the commencing point, and delineated and coloured brown in the plan drawn hereon, for valuable consideration, do hereby dedicate the said land to the Public, to the intent that the same may for ever hereafter be used, and be a Public Highway to all intents and purposes.

ERRATUM.

HIS Honor the Superintendent directs it to be notified that he has made the following Reserves, temporarily, under the 19th clause of the Waste Lands Regulations, for Gravel Pits, viz. :—

No. 1298, in red: Two and a half acres, more or less, situate in the Timaru District, commencing at a point on the Geraldine Road, two chains north-west of the Trigonometrical Station, north of Section 10429, following the said road in a northerly direction a distance of twelve chains, and extending back easterly in a rectangular block, being bounded on the east by the Waihi River.

No. 1299, in red: Five acres, more or less, situate in the Timaru District, commencing at a point on the Geraldine and Pleasant Valley Road, the same being the north-western corner of Section No. 8904; thence southerly following the western boundary of that section a distance of eight chains fifty links; thence westerly at a right angle a distance of about eight chains to the western bank of the old river bed, following the same to the road before mentioned, and from thence returning along that road to the commencing point.
