SHIP "GLENMARK."

COMMISSIONER'S REPORT.

SIR,—In the absence of Captain Gibson, I have the honour to report that I visited the above Ship on the morning of her arrival, and found each compartment allotted to the Government immigrants scrupulously clean, and all the arrangements in conformity with the contract.

I am glad to report that no sickness of any importance occurred during the voyage, and I would add that the Surgeon Superintendent's Journal shows that every attention was paid to carry out those sanitary measures laid down in the instructions issued by the Canterbury Government.

I learnt from the Immigrants in each compartment that the provisions had been served out in accordance with the dietary scale, and that they had been of good quality.

The Distilling Apparatus, under the charge of a skilful Engineer, worked admirably throughout the voyage, and the supply of water was abundant.

The Immigrants generally expressed great satisfaction at the attention they had received from the Captain, Surgeon-Superintendent, and the Officers of the Ship; and no complaints of any kind were made.

The Matron performed her duties in a very satisfactory manner; and the conduct of those under her charge was also exemplary.

I have much pleasure in recommending the payment of all gratuities, and the further employment of the Surgeon-Superintendent, should he desire it.

REPORT OF WORKS CONTRACTED FOR AND CARRIED
OUT DURING THE PAST YEAR.

OPIHI BRIDGE.

This work has been completed, at a cost in all of £2996 13s. 10d., of which the sum of £1068 has been expended during the past year.

A further contract was entered into on the 10th July, 1871, for the extension of this Bridge, at an estimated cost of £500, of which the sum of £371 4s. has been already expended. The contract will be finished in a few days.

RANGITATA BRIDGE.

This work has been proceeded with, and the sum of £15,213 9s. 10d. has been expended on it during the past year. The Engineer reports that the contract should be completed in three months.

LANDING SERVICE AND HARBOUR WORKS.

The contract for repair to the Foreshore and Landing Service has been completed at a cost of £830 11s.

TEMUKA COURT HOUSE.

The contract for this work, from plans by the Provincial Engineer, was taken on the 7th June, 1871. It has been completed at a cost of £190 7s. 6d.
