SCHEDULE.

SOUTHBROOK DISTRICT.

Commencing at the north-west corner of section 1461; thence easterly along the southern boundaries of sections 1508, 983, 1275, 795, 505, 473, 53, 226A, 386, 444, and 926, to the southernmost corner of section 432; thence south-easterly along the road forming the southern boundaries of sections 431, 355A, and 355 to the River Cam; thence southerly along the said river to Young's Road; thence westerly along the said road to Boys' Direct Rangiora Road; thence southerly along the said Boys' Direct Rangiora Road to the south-east corner of Reserve 126; thence westerly along the Ashley and Kaiapoi Road to the
