PROCLAMATION.

**W**HEREAS by a Proclamation bearing date the 5th February, 1872, I, William Rolleston, Superintendent of the Province of Canterbury, in pursuance of a Resolution of the Provincial Council to that effect, did proclaim the Province as a district which it should be lawful for the Waste Lands Board to include in any License to cut timber:

dated the 3rd day of June, 1873, do hereby revoke the said Proclamation.
