## PROCLAMATION.

**W**HEREAS by "The Canterbury Rivers Act, 1870," it is enacted that the Provincial Council may, by resolution, from time to time decide that any part or parts of the Province shall be constituted a district for the purposes of the said Act; and that such resolution shall describe the limits of such district, and designate the name by which such district shall be known, and mention the number of Conservators, being not less than three or more than five, of which the Board of the district shall be constituted. And it is further enacted that so soon as the full number of Members of a Board has been filled up as provided by the said Act, the Superintendent shall by Proclamation in the *New Zealand Gazette* and the *Gazette* of the Province, declare the Board to be duly constituted. And whereas by a resolution passed by the Provincial Council on the Seventh day of May, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-three, it was decided that a part of the Province as therein described should be constituted a district for the purposes of the said Act, under the name of "The Mandeville and Rangiora Drainage District," and that the Board of Conservators for the said district should consist of Five Members. And whereas the full number of the Members of of the Board has been filled up as provided by the said Act:

Now, therefore, I, William Rolleston, Superintendent of the Province of Canterbury, in pursuance of the powers so vested in me as aforesaid, do hereby declare the Board of Conservators for the Mandeville and Rangiora Drainage District to be duly constituted.
