I, WILLIAM ROLLESTON, Superintendent of the Province of Canterbury, in pursuance of the powers vested in me by "The Trespass of Cattle Ordinance, 1872," do hereby proclaim and declare that the Pound established at the Point in the Levels Road Board District in the said Province has been Removed to a site at the Western Corner of Section No. 10247 on the road leading to the Tengawai; and that the Yard erected on the said site shall be taken and deemed to be a Public Pound within the meaning of the said Ordinance from and after the 13th day of May, 1875.
