I, WILLIAM ROLLESTON, Superintendent of the Province of Canterbury, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in me by "The Canterbury Trespass of Cattle Ordinance, 1872," and in pursuance of a recommendation to that effect from the Provincial Council, do hereby, with the advice and consent of my Executive Council, declare that the district commencing at the beach at Trig. pole 45 on the north side of the Waikanui Creek, and extending in a right line running north-west to Trig. pole 15 at I.P.R. fence on boundary between Runs No. 139 and No. 98, thence by a right line crossing the Great South Road, and extending north-west to Trig. pole 12 on north side

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of the Ashburton Road North on Run 124, thence by a right line to north-west boundary of Ashburton Road Board District, at its intersection with the Ashburton Road North, thence by the said north-west boundary to the south side of the south branch of the Ashburton River, thence following the south side of the said branch to the sea, shall be an agricultural district within the meaning of the said Ordinance.
