PROCLAMATION.

By his Honor JOHN CHILTON LAMBTON CARTER, Esq., Superintendent of the Province of Hawke's Bay, in the Islands of New Zealand.

WHEREAS, by an Act passed in the first Session of the Provincial Council of the Province of Wellington, and now in force within the Province of Hawke's Bay, intituled "An Act to make further provisions relative to Fencing within the Districts of the Province," it is enacted that the Superintendent of the Province, should, whenever it should appear to him expedient, declare by Proclamation, that the said Act should come into operation within any Town or District of the Province, and by the same Proclamation declare the limits of such Town or District: Now therefore I, John Chilton Lambton Carter, Superintendent of the Province of Hawke's Bay do hereby Proclaim and Declare that the said above-mentioned Act shall come into operation within the following boundaries, viz—

North by Boundary of Capt. Henton's Run
North-East by Suburban line of the Western Reserve

East by Wairerangi Reserve and Puketapu Road

South by Manganui River, and

West by Manganui River.

Warrant defining District under "The Coroners' Act, 1858."

By his Excellency Sir GEORGE GREY, Knight Commander of the Bath, Governor and Commander-in-chief in and over her Majesty's Colony of New Zealand and its Dependencies, and Vice-Admiral of the same, &c., &c.

WHEREAS by "The Coroner's Act, 1858," the Governor is empowered, in the manner therein mentioned, to appoint fit persons to be Coroners of the several districts of the Colony of New Zealand, and from time to time define the Districts within which such Coroners shall respectively have jurisdiction, and every such definition to revoke or amend and the limits of such Districts to alter as occasion may require. Now, therefore I, Sir George Grey, the Governor of the said Colony, in pursuance of the said power and authority, do hereby define the District of

Napier,

in the Province of Hawke's Bay, to be all the territory comprised within the limits following, that is to say;—On the North by the boundary of the Province of Hawke's Bay; on the East by the Sea Coast as far as the Manawarakau stream; on the West, by the Ruahine Range and boundary of the Province of Hawke's Bay; and on the South, by the Northern boundary of the Waipukurau District.

Given under my hand, at the Government House, at Auckland, this twenty-sixth day of March, One thousand, eight hundred and sixty-two.

Waipukurau,

in the Province of Hawke's Bay, to be all the territory comprised within the limits following, that is to say;—On the North by a line drawn from Taumata-a-Makuru in the Ruahine Range, due East to the junction of the Mangataurie Stream with the Tukituki, thence by the South Bank of the Tukituki to its junction with the Mokokariki Stream at Hawea, thence by the South bank of the Mokokariki to Te Tuhi, thence by a right line to Matahuia on the Manawarakau Stream and thence by the Manawarakau Stream to the sea; on the East by the sea; on the South by the boundary of the Provinces of Hawke's Bay and Wellington; and on the West by the Ruahine Range, being the boundary of the Provinces of Hawke's Bay and Wellington.
