PROCLAMATION.

By JOHN CHILTON LAMBTON CARTER, Esq., Superintendent of the Province of Hawke's Bay, in the Islands of New Zealand.

I, JOHN CHILTON LAMBTON CARTER, Superintendent of the Province of Hawke's Bay, do hereby Proclaim that a Sale of Crown Lands will take place at the Crown Lands Office, Napier, on Thursday, the 29th day of January 1863, at Noon precisely, when the Allotments of Land specified in the Schedule hereunto annexed, and which have been duly certified by the Commissioner of Crown Lands on the application of intending purchasers, as being unavailable for agricultural purposes, will be put up to Public Auction at the upset price of 5s. per acre, in accordance with the Land Regulations of the 4th March 1853 and the additional Regulations for the Amendment and Extension of the said Regulations recommended by the Superintendent and the Council for the Province of Wellington (Session 2) to the Governor.

PROCLAMATION.

By JOHN CHILTON LAMBTON CARTER, Esq., Superintendent of the Province of Hawke's Bay, in the Islands of New Zealand.

FREQUENT instances having occurred of desertion from Her Majesty's Sea and Land Forces in this Colony, notice is hereby given that the most rigorous proceedings will be taken against any person enticing away, harbouring, concealing, or employing Deserters. The enactments relating to the above offence are subjoined for general information.

MILITARY DESERTION.

21 Vic., cap. 9, sec. 88.

"Any person who shall, in any part of Her Majesty's dominions, or by any means whatsoever, directly or indirectly, procure any Soldier to desert, or attempt to procure or persuade any Soldier to desert, and any person who, knowing that any Soldier is about to desert, shall aid or assist him in deserting; or, knowing any Soldier to be a deserter, shall conceal such deserter, or aid or assist such deserter in concealing himself, or aid or assist in his rescue, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor; and shall on conviction thereof, be liable to be punished by fine or imprisonment, or both, as the Court before which such conviction shall take place may adjudge."
