PROCLAMATION.

By DONALD McLEAN, Esq., Superintendent of the Province of Hawke's Bay, in the Islands of New Zealand.

WHEREAS by an Act of the General Assembly of New Zealand, intituled "The Provincial Reserved Bills Act, 1858," it is provided that no Bill reserved for the signification of the Governor's pleasure shall have any force within the Province until the Superintendent shall signify, as therein specified, that it has been laid before the Governor, and that His Excellency has assented to the same: And whereas certain Acts, intituled respectively—

"An Act to repeal the various Acts relating to Sheep, and the disease in Sheep called Scab, and to make other provision in behalf of the same,"

"An Act to appropriate the Revenue of Hawke's Bay for 1863-64,"

"An Act to constitute a Marine Board for

the Port of Napier, to be called the Napier Marine Board," and

"An Act to appoint Commissioners to adjust certain Claims and matters of Account depending between the Provinces of Wellington and Hawke's Bay,"

were passed by the Provincial Council of Hawke's Bay during the late session, but reserved by me for the signification of the Governor's pleasure:

Now, therefore, I, Donald McLean do heretioned Acts have been duly laid before His Excellency the Governor, and having received his assent are, under the provisions of the Act of the General Assembly before referred to, in force within the Province of Hawke's Bay, from the date of this Proclamation.

WHEREAS by the "Diseased Cattle Act, 1861" it was provided that the Governor in Council might by Warrant under his hand from time to time delegate to the Superintendent of any Province within the said Colony all or any of the powers vested in the Governor or Governor in Council by the said Act subject to such Regulations as he might think fit, and might from time to time rescind such Delegation:

Now, therefore, I, Sir George Grey, the Governor of New Zealand, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council thereof, and in pursuance and exercise of the said power and authority, do, by this Warrant under my hand, delegate to

DONALD M'LEAN, Esq.,

so long as he shall hold the office of Superintendent of the Province of Hawke's Bay in the said Colony, the several powers vested in me by the Second, Fourth, Fifth, Seventh, Ninth and Tenth sections of the said Act subject to be rescinded as in the said Act provided and subject to the Regulations One thousand, eight hundred and sixty-two and to any other Regulations to be from time to time duly made.

Delegation to the Superintendent of Hawke's Bay under the "Waste Lands Act, 1858."

By his Excellency Sir GEORGE GREY, Knight, Commander of the most honorable Order of the Bath, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over Her Majesty's Colony of New Zealand and its Dependencies, and Vice-Admiral of

the same, &c., &c.

WHEREAS by the "Waste Lands Act, 1858," the Governor is empowered from time to time to delegate to the Superintendent of any Province or to such other person as he may think fit, all or any of the powers vested in him by Sections Three, Four, and Five, and also by Section Fourteen of the said Act, subject or not to any limitations or restrictions as the Governor may think fit:

Now, therefore, I, Sir George Grey, the Governor of New Zealand, in pursuance of the said power and authority, do hereby delegate to

DONALD M'LEAN, Esq.,

the Superintendent of the Province of Hawke's Bay, all such powers as are vested in me by Section Fourteen of the said Act to be exercised within the limits of the said Province without any limitation or restriction.

PROCLAMATION.

Appointing Circuit Courts to be held at Nelson and Napier.

By his Excellency Sir GEORGE GREY, Knight Commander of the Bath, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over her Majesty's Colony of New Zealand and its Dependencies, and Vice-Admiral of the same, &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS by an Act of the General Assembly of New Zealand, intituled "The Supreme Courts Act, 1860," it is provided that there shall be held Circuit Courts for the despatch of Civil and Criminal business of the Court before one of the Judges thereof, at such times and places as the Governor in Council may from time to time appoint: *And whereas* by a proclamation dated the Twenty-sixth day of February, One thousand, eight hundred and sixty-one, Circuit Courts were appointed to be held for the Middle District of the said Colony, at the Town of Wellington, and at the Town of Nelson, on the several days therein respec-

tively mentioned, and it is expedient that the times so appointed for the holding of such Courts at Nelson aforesaid should be altered as hereafter set forth, and that Circuit Courts should also be holden for the said District at the Town of Napier:

Now, therefore, I, the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of New Zealand, in pursuance and further exercise of the said power and authority, do hereby proclaim and appoint that Circuit Courts for the Middle District of the said Colony shall be held for the despatch of criminal and civil business of the Court, before the Judge thereof to whom the said District has been assigned, at the Town of Nelson, on the sixteenth day of May and the sixteenth day of November, in every year, and at the Town of Napier on the first day of February and the first day of August in every year, or as soon after the said days respectively as conveniently may be; and, in case any one in the said days so fixed as aforesaid shall happen to be a Sunday or holiday, then the Court appointed for such days shall be holden on the day following.
