NOTICE TO MARINERS.

OTAGO HARBOUR, NEW ZEALAND.

Buoys and Beacons.

In order to their being more easily distinguished at night, it has been deemed necessary to arrange the BUOYS and BEACONS in the Channel from the First Anchorage to Dunedin Bay as follows :—

Black—The Port side of the Channel

Red—The Starboard

Striped—That there is a passage on either side

PROCLAMATION.

UNDER DISEASED CATTLE ACT, 1861.

WHEREAS by the Diseased Cattle Act, 1861, it was provided that the Governor in Council might by warrant under his hand from time to time delegate to the Superintendent of any province within the said colony, all or any of the powers vested in the Governor, or Governor in Council, by the said act, subject to such Regulations as he might think fit, and might from time to time

rescind such delegation. And whereas the said Governor hath, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of New Zealand, delegated to Thomas Carter, Esq., so long as he shall hold the office of the Superintendent of the Province of Marlborough, the several powers vested in the said Governor by the second, fourth, fifth, seventh, ninth, and tenth sections of the said act, subject to being rescinded as in the said act provided, and subject to the Regulations issued by the Governor in Council, on the Fifteenth day of September, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-three, and to any other Regulations to be from time to time duly made. And whereas it has been made to appear to me as such Superintendent as aforesaid that the disease called "Pleuro-pneumonia," being an infectious or contagious disease, has broken out amongst cattle within the several districts hereinafter described.

Now, therefore, I, Thomas Carter, by virtue of such powers in me vested, do hereby proclaim and declare that the districts comprising the several Provinces of Otago and Southland, in the Middle Island, and the Districts comprising the several Provinces of Auckland, Wellington, Hawke's Bay, and Taranaki, in the North Island, are infected within the meaning of the said act, and that from and after Monday, the eighteenth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-four no cattle shall be imported from the said districts into the Province of Marlborough.
