PROCLAMATION.

By DONALD M'LEAN, Esquire, Superintendent
of the Province of Hawke's Bay, in the
Islands of New Zealand.

WHEREAS, by an Act of the Superintendent and Provincial Council of Wellington, No. 8 of Session No. 3, intituled "An Act to amend and consolidate the Law relating to Cattle Trespass and Impounding," it is amongst other things enacted that it shall be lawful for the Superintendent, by Proclamation, to declare certain Districts to be Pastoral Districts, and that the said Act, or any clauses thereof which he may specify, shall not apply therein, and at any time to declare that such Districts have ceased to be Pastoral and come within the full operation of the said Act: And Whereas, by a Proclamation under the hand of Isaac Earl Featherston, Superintendent of the Province, and dated the 3rd day of April, one thousand eight hundred and fifty-six, the said Isaac Earl Featherston did declare and proclaim, amongst other things, that a certain District in the said Proclamation described as the portion of the Province of Wellington lying between the Ruahine and Taraua Mountains and the Coast eastwise, excepting amongst other places the Town and Township of Napier, should be a Pastoral District, and that certain clauses of the said Act therein specified should not apply therein: And Whereas the said recited Act hath

been amended by a certain Act of the Superintendent and Provincial Council of Hawke's Bay, No. 8 of Session No. 8, intituled "An Act to amend an Act intituled 'An Act to amend and consolidate the Law relating to Cattle Trespass and Impounding,' Session 3 No. 8 of the Provincial Council of the Province of Wellington:"

And Whereas it is expedient to declare that so much of the said District specified in the Proclamation hereinbefore recited, forming a portion of the Province of Hawke's Bay, as the same is specified and described in the Schedule hereunder, shall cease as, from the date hereof, to be a Pastoral District, and shall come within the operation of the said Acts.

Now therefore, I, DONALD M'LEAN, Superintendent of the Province of Hawke's Bay, Do hereby Proclaim and Declare that all the District specified and described in the Schedule hereunder written shall cease to be a Pastoral District, and shall come within the operation of the said Act, No. 8 of Session No. 3, of the Province of Wellington, as amended by an Act of the Superintendent and Provincial Council of Hawke's Bay, No. 8 of Session No. 8, intituled "An Act to amend an Act intituled 'An Act to amend and consolidate the Law relating to Cattle Trespass and Impounding,' Session 3 No. 8, of the Provincial Council of the Province of Wellington."

SCHEDULE.

- North, by Port Napier from the mouth of the Tutaekuri River, the Warerangi Reserve, the Suburban Land of Western side of Harbour, Captain Henton's Run, and the Tutaekuri River, to the Boundary of the Province.
- East, by the sea-coast from the mouth of the Tutaekuri River to that of the Porangahau River, excluding the Town and Suburban Land of Napier.
- South, by the Porangahau River to its source, and thence in a line due West to the Boundary of the Province.
- West, by the Western Boundary of the Province to the Tutaekuri River.

PROCLAMATION.

By His Honor DONALD M'LEAN, Esq., Superintendent of the Province of Hawke's Bay, in the Islands of New Zealand.

WHEREAS by an Act of the Provincial Council of Wellington, Session 3 No. 8, intituled "An Act to amend and consolidate the Law relating to Cattle Trespass and Impounding," and an Act of Session 8 No. 8 of the Provincial Council of the Province of Hawke's Bay, intituled "An Act to amend an Act and consolidate the Law relating to Cattle Trespass and Impounding," Session 3 No. 8 of the Provincial Council of the Province of Wellington,—It is amongst other things enacted that the Superintendent may from time to time by Proclamation declare any Pounds to be, or cease to be Public Pounds within the meaning of the said Acts and may from time to time in like manner appoint keepers of such Pounds.

Now, therefore, I, Donald M'Lean, Superintendent of the Province of Hawke's Bay, do hereby proclaim that the respective persons and places hereinafter mentioned shall be Poundkeepers and Public Pounds:—
