By His Honor DONALD M'LEAN, Esq.,  
Superintendent of the Province of  
Hawke's Bay, in the Islands of  
New Zealand.

I, DONALD M'LEAN, Superintendent  
of the Province of Hawke's Bay, in  
pursuance of the power and authority  
vested in me on this behalf, Do hereby  
proclaim and appoint that the Provincial  
Council of Hawke's Bay shall meet for  
the despatch of business, at the Council  
Chamber, at Napier, on TUESDAY, the  
25th instant, at three o'clock p.m.

PROCLAMATION.

By His Honor JOSEPH RHODES,  
Esquire, Deputy-Superintendent  
of the Province of Hawke's Bay,  
in the Islands of New Zealand.

WHEREAS by an Act of the General  
Assembly of New Zealand, inti-  
tuled "The Provincial Reserved Bills  
Act, 1858," it is provided that no Bill re-  
served for the signification of the Go-  
vernor's pleasure shall have any force  
within the Province until the Superinten-  
dent shall signify, as therein specified,  
that it has been laid before the Governor,  
and that His Excellency has assented to  
the same.

And whereas an Act intituled "The  
Papakura and Hikutoto Leasing Bill"  
was passed by the Provincial Council of  
Hawke's Bay during the last Session, but  
reserved by me for the signification of the  
Governor's pleasure.

Now, therefore, I, Joseph Rhodes, Do  
hereby proclaim and notify that the above  
mentioned Act has been duly laid before  
His Excellency the Governor, and having  
received his assent, is, under the provi-  
sions of the Act of the General Assembly  
before referred to, in force within the  
Province of Hawke's Bay from the date  
of this Proclamation.

PROCLAMATION.

By DONALD M'LEAN, Esquire, Su-  
perintendent of the Province of  
Hawke's Bay, in the Colony of  
New Zealand.

WHEREAS by an Act of the General  
Assembly of New Zealand, intituled  
"Protection of certain Animals Act 1865,"  
it is provided that the Governor may, by  
Order in Council, under his hand from  
time to time, delegate to any Super-  
intendent all or any of the powers vested  
in the Governor or the Governor in Coun-  
cil by the aforesaid Act, subject to such  
Regulations as he may think fit, and may  
from time to time rescind such Delega-  
tion.

And whereas, by an order in Council  
dated the 24th day of August, 1866, the  
Governor hath delegated to me, Donald  
M'Lean, as Superintendent of the Pro-  
vince of Hawke's Bay, all the powers  
vested in him the said Governor as Go-  
vernor or as Governor in Council by the  
aforesaid Act, so long as I, the said  
Donald M'Lean, shall continue and remain  
Superintendent of the said Province and  
no longer.

Now, therefore, I, the said Donald M'Lean, Superintendent as aforesaid, by virtue of the powers vested in me in this behalf, do hereby proclaim and declare that the 4th Section of the aforesaid Act "The Protection of certain Animals Act 1865," shall be in force and effect, and shall come into operation as from the day of the date hereof.

#### ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House, at Wellington, the 24th day of August, 1866.

PRESENT:—

His Excellency the Governor in Council.

WHEREAS by an Act of the General Assembly intituled "Protection of certain Animals' Act, 1865," it is provided that the Governor may, by Order in Council under his hand from time to time delegate to any Superintendent all or any of the powers vested in the Governor or the Governor in Council by the aforesaid Act, subject to such Regulations as he may think fit, and may from time to time rescind such delegation.

Now, therefore, I, Sir George Grey, the Governor as aforesaid of the said Colony, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council thereof, and in exercise of the power and authority for this purpose in me vested, do hereby delegate unto

DONALD M'LEAN, ESQUIRE,

as Superintendent, of the Province of Hawke's Bay, all the powers vested in me as Governor or as Governor in Council by the aforesaid Act, to have, hold, and exercise within the Province of Hawke's Bay the said powers hereby delegated to the said Donald M'Lean, so long as he shall continue and remain Superintendent of the said Province and no longer: Provided always that copies of all instruments signed or issued by the Superintendent under such delegation shall be further transmitted to the Colonial Secretary for record.
