NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Provincial Government of Hawke's Bay, will award a Sum or Sums of Money, not exceeding in the whole the amount of One Thousand Pounds Sterling, payable to any one person, or distributable rateably amongst any number of persons, who shall discover and make known to the Government the existence of an available Gold Field within the Province of Hawke's Bay.

All claims for the payment of this Reward, or any portion of it, are to be sent in to the Government, addressed to the Superintendent in the first instance, by whom they will be afterwards referred to the decision of a Commission consisting of three persons, to be named by the Superintendent.

By "available Gold Field" is meant a district within which Gold shall be judged by the Commissioners to exist capable of affording employment to a body of not less than six hundred (600) diggers at a remunerate rate of wages.

Naval & Military Settlers' Act, 1861.
