**I** JOHN DAVIES ORMOND, Superintendent of the Province of Hawke's Bay, do hereby proclaim that a sale of Crown Lands will take place at the Crown Lands Office, Napier, on TUESDAY, May 31st, 1870, at noon precisely, when the allotments of land specified in the schedule hereunto annexed, except such as may be reserved under the provision hereinafter mentioned, and which have been duly certified by the Commissioner of Crown Lands on the application of intending purchasers, as being unavailable for agricultural purposes, will be put up to Public Auction at the upset price of 5s. an acre, in accordance with the Land Regulations of the 4th March, 1853, and the additional regulations for the amendment and extension of the said Regulations recommended by the Superintendent and the Council for the Province of Wellington (Session 2) to the Governor.
