WHEREAS by an Act of the General Assembly of New Zealand, intituled the "Provincial Reserved Bills Act, 1858," it is provided that no Bill, reserved for the signification of the Governor's pleasure, shall have any force within the Province until the Superintendent shall signify, as therein specified, that it has been laid before the Governor, and that His Excellency has assented to the same; and whereas certain Acts intituled—

- "Diversion of Roads Bill, 1870 "
- "The Cattle Trespass and Impounding Act Amendment Act, 1870 "
- "The Credit Act, 1870 "
- "The Hawke's Bay Appropriation Act, 1870,"

were passed by the Provincial Council of Hawke's Bay during this Session, but reserved by me for the signification of the Governor's pleasure.
