PROCLAMATION.

By JOHN DAVIES ORMOND, Esq., Superintendent of the Province of Hawke's Bay, in the Islands of New Zealand.

WHEREAS by the "Educational Rates Act, 1868," it is enacted that the Superintendent shall appoint proper persons to collect the rates, to be collected by virtue of the said Act; and whereas by a Proclamation under his hand dated the 15th day of October, 1870, he appointed John Farmer as a proper person to collect the said rates; and whereas it is expedient that Robert Moffit should be appointed as the person to collect the same in the place of John Farmer.
